and thus have causal powers over human affairs and he rejects astral fatalism because it renders absurd the notion of moral responsibility concerning the question of theodicy philo proceeds from the platonian premise that god is not the cause for evil in any way for him the existence of moral evil exonerates god and his providence as the cause for evil and anchors the blame in the person
