in geoffrey chaucer s the canterbury tales key structural moments arise when a speaker shifts from rhyming heroic couplets to address the reader in prose as well as in instances where prose is mentioned but not employed these interruptions may seem like glosses explaining chaucer s intentions yet they occur during the most contradictory moments of the frame narrative making
