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as part of its effort to expose communist infiltration in the united states and eliminate communist influence on movies from 1947 1953 the house committee on un american activities subpoenaed hundreds of movie industry employees suspected of membership in the communist party most of them including screenwriter paul jarrico 1915 1997 invoked the fifth amendment and refused to answer questions about their political associations they were all blacklisted in the marxist and the movies larry ceplair narrates the life movie career and political activities of jarrico the recipient of an oscar nomination for his screenplay for tom dick and harry 1941 and the producer of salt of the earth 1954 one of the most politically besieged films in the history of the united states though jarrico did not reach the upper echelon of screenwriting he worked steadily in hollywood until his blacklisting he was one of the movie industry s most engaged communists working on behalf of dozens of social and political causes song of russia 1944 was one of the few assignments that allowed him to express his political beliefs through his screenwriting craft though mgm planned the film as a conventional means of boosting domestic support for the ussr a wartime ally of the united states it came

under attack by a host of anti communists jarrico fought the blacklist in many ways and his greatest battle involved the making of salt of the earth jarrico other blacklisted individuals and the families of the miners who were the subject of the film created a landmark film in motion picture history as did others on the blacklist jarrico decided that europe offered a freer atmosphere than that of the cold war united states although he continued to support political causes while living abroad he found it difficult to find remunerative black market screenwriting assignments on the scripts he did complete he had to use a pseudonym or allow the producers to give screen credit to others upon returning to the united states in 1977 he led the fight to restore screen credits to the blacklisted writers who like himself had been denied screen credit from the late 1940s to the mid 1960s despite all the obstacles he encountered jarrico never lost his faith in the progressive potential of movies and the possibility of a socialist future the marxist and the movies details the relationship between a screenwriter s work and his communist beliefs from jarrico s immense archive interviews with him and those who knew him best and a host of other sources ceplair has crafted an insider s view of paul jarrico s life and work placing both in the context of u s cultural history

ed brubaker b 1966 has emerged as one of the most popular significant figures in art comics since the 1990s most famous as the man who killed captain america in 2007 brubaker s work on company owned properties such as batman and captain america and creator owned series like criminal and fatale live up to the usual expectations for the superhero and crime genres and yet brubaker layers his stories with a keen self awareness applying his expansive knowledge of american comic book history to invigorate his work and challenge the dividing line between popular entertainment and high art this collection of interviews explores the sophisticated artist s work drawing upon the entire length of the award winning brubaker s career with his stints writing catwoman gotham central and daredevil brubaker advanced the work of crime comic book writers through superhero stories informed by hard boiled detective fiction and film noir during his time on captain america and his series sleeper and incognito brubaker revisited the conventions of the espionage thriller with double agents who lose themselves in their jobs the stories expose the arbitrary superhero standards of good and evil in his series criminal brubaker offered complex crime stories and with a clear sense of the complicated lost world before the comics code rejected crusading critic fredric wertham s myth of the innocence of early comics overall brubaker demonstrates his self conscious methodology in these often little known and hard to find interviews worthwhile conversations in their own right as well as objects of study for both scholars and researchers

the american theater was not ignorant of the developments brought on by world war ii and actively addressed and debated timely controversial topics for the duration of the war including neutrality and isolationism racism and genocide and heroism and battle fatigue productions such as watch on the rhine 1941 the moon is down 1942 tomorrow the world 1943 and a bell for adano 1944 encouraged public discussion of the war s impact on daily life and raised critical questions about the conflict well before other forms of popular media american drama of the 1940s is frequently overlooked but the plays performed during this eventful decade provide a picture of the rich and complex experience of living in the united states during the war

years mclaughlin and parry s work fills a significant gap in the history of theater and popular culture showing that american society was more divided and less idealistic than the received histories of the wwii home front and the entertainment industry recognize
