this book offers students a clear and systematic overview of procedures for peaceful dispute settlement in international law

this text examines key concepts in international law in order to illuminate them in the context of international relations the first part of the book covers theoretical issues the second part examines international law in context including case study material and the Pinochet litigation

how do aspiring and established rising global powers respond to conflict using China the book studies its response to wars and rivalries in the middle east from the cold war to the present since the People's Republic was established in 1949 China has long been involved in the middle east and its conflicts from exploiting or avoiding them to their management containment or resolution using a conflict and peace studies angle Burton adopts a broad perspective on Chinese engagement by looking at its involvement in the region's conflicts including Israel Palestine Iraq before and after 2003 Sudan and the Darfur crisis the Iranian nuclear deal the Gulf crisis and the wars in Syria Libya and Yemen the book reveals how a rising global and non-western power handles the challenges associated with both violent and nonviolent conflict and the differences between limiting and reducing violence alongside other ways to eliminate the causes of conflict and grievance contributing to the wider discipline of international relations and peace and conflict studies this book will be of interest to students and scholars of peace and conflict studies Chinese foreign policy and the politics and international relations of the middle east

from conflict resolution to peacebuilding is designed to introduce students to the key concepts of conflict resolution from a real world perspective covering both micro and macro sites of conflict it offers ways to resolve conflicts at all levels from the interpersonal to the international starting with the notion that conflict is a fact of life but peacebuilding is not this text analyzes protracted conflicts and wicked problems and also tackles the harder task of how to resolve conflict and build peace Hauss approach to peace and conflict studies is deeply personal and richly informed based on a strong research base and decades of experience in the field the book offers new paradigms for considering the intractable conflicts in our world each chapter provides real world examples stories and cases that illustrating practical work at both the grass roots and elite levels in a world where conflict seems to be on the rise at home and abroad this text provides students with the tools to deal with conflict constructively in their daily lives as citizens and as future professionals in the growing field of conflict resolution features full suite of textboxes for study and

this book is designed to present a fully developed theory of international crisis and conflict along with substantial evidence of these two closely related phenomena the book begins with a discussion of these topics at a theoretical level defining and elaborating on core concepts international crisis interstate conflict severity and impact this is followed by a discussion of the international system along with two significant illustrations the berlin blockade crisis 1948 and the india pakistan crisis over kashmir 1965 66 the book then presents a unified model of crisis focusing on the four phases of an international crisis which incorporate the four periods of foreign policy crises for individual states findings from thirteen conflicts representing six regional clusters are then analyzed concluding with a set of hypotheses and evidence on conflict onset persistence and resolution

benjamin macqueen presents an innovative and in depth look at contemporary conflict resolution in the arab middle east developing a unique theory of political culture through his analysis of peace processes in lebanon and algeria moving beyond conventional perspectives political culture and conflict resolution in the arab world highlights that while culture can serve as a key to resolving and transforming conflict if neglected it can act to worsen the conditions that lead to conflict this book represents a critical advance in the study of conflict and its resolution in the arab world islamic studies series volume 3

the contributors to this fully revised volume a team of international experts with both academic and professional experience in the field provide a broad range of geographical and disciplinary perspectives covering theory research and practice they analyze the different types of conflict and offer a thorough examination of the influences on conflict structural situational strategic and cultural exploring conflict management and resolution they also discuss negotiation mediation peace keeping and peace building

the analysis and interpretation of conflicts can be a dangerously simplistic exercise a western developed socio economic perspective can simplify conflicts in the so called third world as the inevitable struggles of people who cannot coexist because of

ethnic religious or cultural differences while acknowledging that many contemporary conflicts are characterised and influenced by these factors this book calls for an approach to conflict prevention and resolution which mainly addresses the underlying political economic and social causes the conflict in sudan where narratives evolved from an interpretation based on religious differences between a muslim north and the christian south provides a case study through which the author explores how most prevention and resolution strategies were based on flawed assumptions leading to poor results by focusing instead on the underlying socio economic inequality and marginalisation among groups she analyses the dynamics of the complex peace process to ascertain if and how economic and social rights were effectively included and implemented as a part of the peace agreement including after south sudan s independence

never have international relations between nations been so complex as in the current political climate in this contemporary world international negotiation has become a combination of traditional diplomacy and the modern framework of conferences multi party institutions and organizations such as the european union while this diplomacy has in the past existed to prevent national and international conflict its scope has expanded to deal with other problems facing us on a global scale as negotiation is the primary tool to resolve international conflict an understanding of the methods and principles of international negotiation remains essential only this form of diplomacy can hope to answer the global challenges we will face in the twenty first century international negotiation in the twenty first century is an accessible examination of negotiation and diplomacy on an international scale and is the first publication to analyze this fundamental concept in a single volume

instead of proposing another theory of war their goal is a more modest one of raising the theoretical consciousness of historians specifically they argue that 1 ideology does influence theory 2 historians do have ideologies as well as theories about which they are not always conscious or consistent and 3 we can better understand compare and evaluate what historians are saying when we comprehend their ideological and theoretical perspectives they attempt then to classify historical interpretations of war according to their ideological theoretical orientations however covert perspective nelson and olin are concerned with enhancing history s social utility by advancing its capacity to produce generalizations that can explain or predict events and are subject to empirical testing their exploration of historical generalization focuses on an issue itself of the highest importance the causes of war but their aim is also to create a model for historical generalization applicable to other issues they argue that to understand generalizations in history one must recognize their roots in theory and that historians theories in turn proceed from their own
