this book analyses the rise in xenophobia racism and radical right political parties movements and violent groups over recent years the author provides a summary of the current state of international and interdisciplinary research on the multilevel explanations of right wing radical thought comparing similarities and differences across europe and the united states by integrating findings from psychology history social and life sciences he proposes a biopsychosociological model of the conditions causes catalysts and triggers of phenomena of the radical right across the world following a demand and supply analysis wahl explores the interaction of evolutionary emotional mechanisms and socialization processes with various environmental conditions and consequent manifestations of radical right groups to identify strategies to slow down the rise and effects of the radical right

the radical right has represented a major element in german politics and society throughout the history of the united country i e since the 1870s though the understandable concentration on the third reich 1933 45 has tended to distort the wider picture this book explores the history of the radical right through the full span of germany s life as a nation thus putting the third reich in

its natural context and also emphasising that the attitudes and policies of the radical right did not begin with Hitler's pursuit of power in the 1920s or end with his death in the ruins of Berlin

The Cold War may be over but there is no shortage of enemies in a world beset by resurgent nationalism, ethnic conflict and economic rivalry. Right-wing extremists from David Duke to Jean-Marie Le Pen know how to exploit the pressure points of race, religion and culture in a bid to keep the national and international conflict industry cooking. disorganised parties the author argues that the failure to develop a functioning party organisation has resulted in australian far right parties being unable to effectively navigate their political environment by focusing on disorganisation this book provides a new perspective for understanding the limited electoral impact of the far right in australia today despite favourable conditions like normalised islamophobia and growing dissatisfaction with mainstream parties this book will be of interest to scholars and students of party politics the far right populism and australian politics
