October 7 1966 Alexie grew up in the Spokane Indian Reservation in Washington. Nowadays Alexie lives in Seattle, Washington, together with his Native American wife and his two sons. He is a famous Native American poet, author, screenwriter, and filmmaker. He sold millions of copies of his books and won several awards for his novels like the Boston Globe Horn Book Award for the best fiction novel of 2008 in young adult literature or the National Book Award for Young People's Literature in 2007. Both for his novel "The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian" his literature is very important for Native American literature courses in the United States and in the world. Alexie is also read in colleges and universities all across the USA as a Native American himself. His novels, films, and collections of short stories deal with a variety of topics he experienced in the reservation like alcoholism, poverty, stereotypes, friends, death, or family problems. Having grown up in the 60s and 70s in the reservation, Alexie has made lots of experiences on many if not all topics he writes about.
