circumstance that brought about the letter accordingly paul made a request he wanted philemon to forgive a runaway slave onesimus and receive him as a brother in christ as the apostle found him useful in god s service pursuant to philemon 1 11 14 paul did not minimize onesimus s sin however there was sacrifice required in this request and because of that apostle paul approached the request with gentleness and care as exhibited in philemon 1 21 his letter to philemon vividly presents the beautiful and majestic transition from slavery to kinship that comes as a result of christian love and forgiveness the bible says bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone forgive as the lord forgave you
