At fifteen, Howard began to read the pulp magazines of the day and to write more seriously. The December 1922 issue of his high school newspaper featured two of his stories, *Golden Hope* and *Christmas and West is West*. In 1924, he sold his first piece, a short caveman tale titled *Spear and Fang*, for 16¢ to the not yet famous *Weird Tales* magazine. Howard's most famous character, Conan the Cimmerian, was a barbarian turned king during the Hyborian Age, a mythical period of some 12,000 years ago. Conan featured in seventeen *Weird Tales* stories between 1933 and 1936, which is why Howard is now regarded as having spawned the sword and sorcery genre. The Conan stories have since been adapted many times, most famously in the series of films starring Arnold Schwarzenegger.
