conflict be it war between states ethnic violence civil war or terrorist activity endures despite immense efforts to end it how do states cope with conflict minimize future threats and reduce the risk of insecurity morgan outlines a spectrum of solutions states use to manage violent conflict ranging from strategies that individual governments enact largely on their own such as distribution of power deterrence or arms control to those such as collective security and multilateralism that are more global in nature the book progresses into tactical and practical actions from negotiation and mediation to peace imposition morgan evaluates each strategy and tactic in terms of how well it addresses three levels of security systemic state and societal to show how they are interrelated and complementary to each other in important ways addressing insecurity at one level often elicits further insecurity at another morgan shows students how these various levels interact either to a state s advantage or to its detriment so they can comprehensively analyze the ways that political actors manage or incite conflict useful pedagogical features help students master the material terms and concepts boxes go beyond simple definitions and provide students with a concept s evolution over time or the controversy surrounding the meaning of a certain term cases and context boxes offer needed background and interesting detail about pivotal cases of conflict both historical and contemporary in nature key terms are bolded throughout and compiled in a glossary annotated bibliographic essays at the end of each chapter point students to additional sources for further study

and the role played by the un nato and other organizations in maintaining international peace and security part 3 assesses the challenges of environmental security including the threat of resource based conflict most notably over oil and water and the perceived security challenges of international migration part 4 discusses the new security challenges posed by international terrorism the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction and cyber warfare it explores the strategies and policies adopted by the united states particularly in the aftermath of 9 11 and assesses the implications of the rise of china and other emerging powers this book will be essential reading for students and analysts of international relations international security and strategic studies

peace and security and raise new ethical legal and political questions about the use of power and the role of humans in war and conflict this book makes a contribution to these debates by considering emerging technologies across three levels of analysis 1 the international system systemic level including the balance of power 2 the state and its role in international affairs and how these technologies are redefining and challenging the state s traditional roles and 3 the relationship between the state and society including how these technologies affect individuals and non state actors this provides specific insights at each of these levels and generates a better understanding of the connections between the international and the local when it comes to technological advance across time and space the chapters examine the implications of these technologies for the balance of power examining the strategies of the us russia and china to harness ai robotics and automation and how their militaries and private corporations are responding how smaller and less powerful states and non state actors are adjusting the political ethical and legal implications of ai and automation what these technologies mean for how war and power is understood and utilized in the 21st century and how these technologies diffuse power away from the state to society individuals and non state actors this volume will be of much interest to students of international security science and technology studies law philosophy and international relations

from war terrorism and weapons of mass destruction through environmental and economic crises to epidemics cyber war and piracy the twenty first century world seems beset by a daunting range of international security problems at the same time the academic study of security has become more fragmented and contested than ever before as new actors issues and theories increasingly challenge traditional concepts and approaches this innovative new text focuses on the politics of international security how and why issues are interpreted as threats to international security and how such threats are managed after a brief introduction to the field and its major theories and approaches the core chapters systematically analyze the major issues on the contemporary international security agenda each is examined according to a common framework that brings out the nature of the threat and the responses open to policy makers

this dictionary provides readers with a handy reference guide to the field of international security by including over 200 articles on a wide range of concepts issues treaties and

institutions from absolute war to weapons of mass destruction

shaped by often very dramatic events international security and the international system have changed significantly in recent years the conclusion of the cold war the emergence of new political systems the growth of significant threats such as terrorism and the development of new security doctrines have driven global transformation these volumes provide detailed information on countries from every geographic region and continent on the globe evaluating their relationship with the united states and measuring the potential security threats posed by each the contributors consider factors such as geography and history the political systems of each state their human rights records the ability to maintain law and order and provide security within their own borders the impact of current administrations rulers or regimes on a nation s foreign policy and the regional factors that often dictate local politics in order to make their assessments all of the entries in this set follow a standardized outline and present a concise but detailed assessment of each country each entry begins with a discussion of geography through which the contributors identify the state s natural resources environmental issues and the extent of its territorial jurisdiction the focus then shifts to social and political organizations populations are broken down by not only numbers but by ethnic and religious affiliations access to health care education housing and income all of those aspects are often a reflection of the system of government in place like the united states those governments are comprised of different parties or leaders with various interests the contributors assess those entities and interests within each country they measure the ways in which factors of religion nationalism and globalism impact and shape not only domestic policies but also foreign policy and ultimately the country s relationship to the united states other areas such as military organizations and activities records on human rights and justice recognition of and adherence to international conventions and national attitudes towards security are also considered every entry also includes an assessment of current and potential security issues and an analysis of current terrorist threats that may already be in place or that are beginning to develop in various nations each entry concludes with a summary of current relationships with the united states those relationships are defined by the identification and brief analysis of formal trade aid or military treaties in place between the united states and other nations the general attitude of a nation s citizenry and its government towards the u s and finally identifying any social and cultural links between

nations and the u s migration patterns language economies finally possible changes and trends that will impact security issues are identified by the contributors taken in their entirety these encyclopedias contain a wealth of information in a concise format that will serve as a valuable reference guide not only for specialists but general readers as well

this textbook presents security studies as a branch of international relations theory providing readers with the critical conceptual tools to develop their expertise the author evaluates the claims of rival theories realism neorealism liberal institutionalism classical economic liberalism and marxism to explain why international actors choose or eschew force and coercive threats in order to elicit favorable outcomes in their interdependent exchanges also discussed are behaviorism and constructivism contesting approaches to validate prevailing security paradigms the author argues that only an interdisciplinary approach to security drawing on the insights of each perspective can meet the rigorous requirements of testable theory and the practical needs of actors in an increasingly globalizing world the book will provide students and scholars of international relations and security studies with a valuable survey of the subject and includes essay questions and guides to further reading

international security is an ambiguous concept it has many meanings to many people without an idea of how the world works or how security is defined and achieved it is impossible to create effective policies to provide security this textbook clarifies the concept of security the debates around it how it is defined and how it is pursued tracking scholarly approaches within security studies against empirical developments in international affairs historical and contemporary security issues are examined through various theoretical and conceptual models chapters cover a wide range of topics including war and warfare political violence and terrorism cyber security environmental security energy security economic security and global public health students are supported by illustrative vignettes bolded key terms and an end of book glossary maps box features discussion questions and further reading suggestions and instructors have access to adaptable lecture slides

this book develops the idea that since decolonisation regional patterns of security have become more prominent in international politics the authors combine an operational theory of regional security with an empirical application across the whole of the international system

individual chapters cover africa the balkans cis europe east asia eu europe the middle east north america south america and south asia the main focus is on the post cold war period but the history of each regional security complex is traced back to its beginnings by relating the regional dynamics of security to current debates about the global power structure the authors unfold a distinctive interpretation of post cold war international security avoiding both the extreme oversimplifications of the unipolar view and the extreme deterritorialisations of many globalist visions of a new world disorder their framework brings out the radical diversity of security dynamics in different parts of the world

helping students identify and discuss main issues in international security today this book evaluates the contending schools of thought and their key assumptions it explains why states use or chose not to use force to promote their causes each philosophy is tested in terms of its capacity to explain the rise and demise of the cold war and to address the security challenges confronting the peoples and states of the twenty first century the book also contains essay questions and guides to further reading

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
