the boundaries between skin and clothing are fluid as they are between art and fashion both meet in the space where new visual discoveries are made where materials are tried out and current concepts of beauty are critiqued fashion designers use extreme hyperbole and fantastical exaggeration to re interpret traditional ideas about clothing or even the entire fashion system and so change our understanding of these the exhibition and catalogue explore this intriguing border region and demonstrate how these disciplines are interlinked in a constant process of investigation and inspiration for example in rees leather skins le mindu s hair sculptures or the wax child s shoe by gober artists designers included sandra backlund walter van beirendonck bless louise bourgeois nick cave helen chadwick hussein chalyan comme des garçons rei kawakubo christophe coppens salvador dalí naomi filmer robert gober maison martin margiela charlie le mindu dai rees freddie robins elsa schiaparelli manfredu schu jana sterbak francesco vezzoli viktor rolf and anna nicole ziesche published on the occasion of the exhibition art fashion between skin and clothing at kunstmuseum wolfsburg 5 march to 7 august 2011

in fashion and imagination the frame of reference is the current debate on the relationship

between fashion and art the book consists of five thematic chapters containing contributions from a number of respected scholarly authors the first chapter focuses on the relationship between art and fashion in general with the authorship and the artistic aspect of fashion as principal subjects the four other themes each underscore essential and elementary aspects of fashion that have played a major role in fashion history and remain significant today case studies on specific subjects designers and artists are included e g showstudio com the reform movement wiener werkstatte futurism the russian avant garde maison martin margiela nick cave vanessa beecroft viktor rolf

for at least two centuries fashion and art have maintained a competitive love hate relationship both fashion and art construct imaginary worlds and use a language of style to invigorate beliefs perceptions and ideas until now the crossovers of fashion and art have received only scattered treatment and suffered from a dearth of theorization as an attempt to theorize the area this collection of new and updated essays is the most well rounded and authoritative to date some of the world s foremost scholars in the field are assembled here to explore the art fashion nexus in numerous ways from aesthetics and performance to masquerade and media original and inspiring this book will not only secure art fashion as a discrete area of study but also suggest new critical pathways for exploring their continuing cross pollination fashion and art is essential reading for students and scholars of fashion art history and theory cultural studies and related fields

fashion reveals not only who we are but whom we aspire to be from 1775 to 1925 artists in europe were especially attuned to the gaps between appearance and reality participating in and often critiquing the making of the self and the image reading their portrayals of modern life with an eye to fashion and dress reveals a world of complex calculations and subtle signals fashion in european art explores the significance of historical dress over this period of upheaval as well as the lived experience of dress and its representation drawing on visual sources that extend from paintings and photographs to fashion plates caricatures and advertisements the expert contributors consider how artists and their sitters engaged with the fashion and culture of their times they explore the politics of dress its inspirations and the reactions it provoked as well as the many meanings of fashion in european art revealing its importance in understanding modernity itself

artificial bodies constructed in human likeness from uncanny automatons to mechanical dolls have long played a complex and subtle role in human identity and culture this book takes a range of these bodies from antiquity to the present day to explore how we seek out echoes caricatures and replications of ourselves in order to make sense of the complex world in which we live packed with case studies from the commedia del arte to hans bellmer and the 1980s supermodel this volume explores the divide between the real and the constructed arguing that the body other plays a crucial role in the formation of the self physically and psychologically leading scholar adam geczy contends that the natural body has been replaced by a series of imaginary archetypes in our post modern world central to which is the figure of the doll the artificial body in fashion and art provides a much needed synthesis of constructed bodies across time and place drawing on fashion theory theatre studies and material culture to explore what the body means in the realms of identity gender performance and art
