this book examines the intersection of organizational behavior management obm and industrial and organizational psychology i o psychology it argues that whilst obm and i o psychology have developed simultaneously they have done so with minimal integration i o psychology a somewhat older field has evolved to become widely accepted both influencing management and social sciences and being affected by them it can be viewed as a research oriented subject that is closely aligned with human resources functions with regards to the intersection of i o psychology with obm some practices are more closely related than others and of those that are related some are relatively consistent with obm practices while others are very inconsistent

most i o psychology interventions focus on many people simultaneously seeking to ensure that one intervention affects multiple employees as a cost efficient way to improve organizations while obm is usually better than i o psychology at improving the behaviors of individuals and smaller groups or workers this book provides a framework for understanding differences and similarities between i o psychology and obm and as such is an innovative compendium for students scholars applied psychologists and human resource specialists it was originally published as a special issue of the journal of organizational behavior management
