this book advances a new interpretation of hart's penal philosophy positioning itself in opposition to current interpretations the book argues that hart does not defend a mixed theory of punishment nor a rule utilitarian theory of punishment nor a liberal form of utilitarianism nor a goal constraint approach rather it is argued his penal philosophy is based on his moral pluralism which

comprises two aspects value pluralism and pluralism with respect to forms of moral reason it is held that this means on the one hand that criminal law has an irreducible complexity due to the compromises it makes to accommodate competing values and on the other hand that there need not be one single justification of punishment this original interpretation is not based only on hart s key volume on the subject punishment and responsibility but on a careful reading of his complete works the book will be a valuable resource for academics and researchers interested in hart s philosophy the philosophy of law and criminal law
