that was still for a while at least in rude health despite the column inches devoted to punk in this informative readable and for punk fans at least annoying book kevan furbank looks at the progressive rock bands and albums that left punk reeling in the moshpit to misquote the sex pistols never mind the b llocks here s the progressive rock of 1977 the author now happily retired kevan furbank was managing editor of reach ireland publishers of the irish daily mirror and the irish daily star and a journalist on local and national newspapers for more than 40 years he has published books on local history and written stories articles and columns on practically every subject under the sun this is his fifth book for sonicbond his music tastes encompass prog rock folk and jazz and in his spare time he likes to pretend he can play guitar bass ukulele bouzouki and keyboards he is married with two grown up daughters and lives in northern ireland
