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if there was ever a ring tailed roarer of the backwoods of new mexico he was quentin hulse 1926 2002 hulse lived and worked most of his life at the bottom of canyon creek in the gila river country of southwestern new mexico but his reputation spread far and wide his western image appeared on a tourist postcard and souvenir license plate in the 1950s footage of a lion hunt led by hulse and his hounds appeared on the men s channel in 2005 three years after his passing hulse grew up primarily in western new mexico when that ranch and mining country was still remote and raw at the age of ten he witnessed a point blank shooting the culmination of an old fashioned frontier feud he followed his parents between mines and towns until his father established a ranch at canyon creek while serving in the navy during world war ii he landed on the bloody beach

at okinawa after returning from the war he was shot in a bar near silver city during a night of carousing hulse was most at home in the rugged gila wilderness in which he ranched and guided for fifty years with compassion and nuance nancy coggeshall tells the compelling biography of a unique western rancher constantly adjusting to the inroads of modernity into his traditional way of life drawing on oral history archival sources and her personal association with hulse and the gila she brings this unique westerner and new mexican to life

in trespassing boundaries ten contemporary woolf scholars discuss a broad range of woolf s short stories despite being now easily available these stories have not yet received the attention they deserve complex yet involving they deserve to be read not only for the light they shed on the novels but in their own right as major contributions to the short fiction as a genre this volume places woolf s short stories in the context of modernist experimentalism then explores them as ambitious attempts to challenge generic boundaries undercutting traditional distinctions between short fiction and the novel between experimental and popular fiction between fiction and nonfiction collectively the essays suggest that woolf s contribution to the short story is as important as her contribution to the novel

augusta victoria mary alexandra and zita were four women who were born to rule in imperial requiem justin c vovk narrates the epic story of four women who were married to the reigning monarchs of europe's last empires during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries using a diverse array of primary and secondary sources letters diary entries and interviews with descendants vovk provides an in depth look into the lives of four extraordinary women who stayed faithfully at their husbands sides throughout the cataclysm of the first world war and the tumultuous years that followed at the centers of these four great monarchies were augusta victoria germany's revered empress whose unwavering commitment to her bombastic husband made her a national icon mary whose cinderella story and immense personal strength made her the soul of the british monarchy through some of its greatest crises alexandra the ill fated tsarina who helped topple the russian monarchy through her ineffective rule and zita the resolute empress of austria whose story of loss and exile captivated the world's attention for seven decades imperial requiem shares the fascinating story of four princesses who married for love graced imperial thrones and watched as their beloved worlds were torn apart by war revolution heartache and loss

when catherine tudish's story collection tenney's landing was published in 2005 margot livesey said tudish casts an irresistible spell and david huddle said tenney's landing conjures up a place and a people with that magical vividness we found in porter welty cheever and updike here in her first novel tudish has fashioned a masterful and intimate portrait of a woman returning midlife to the small farming community where she grew up after nathan rownd is injured in a tractor accident his daughter virginia leaves her suburban life and returns to tenney's landing with her teenage son to work the family farm she struggles with the long periods of separation from her husband and begrudgingly relearns the insistent exhausting cadence of farm chores but when nathan decides to sell the farm virginia realizes how deep her connection to the land is and begins to question who she is and where she belongs catherine tudish's writing is a tribute to small town america in simple elegant prose she captures the rhythms of everyday life and the moments of truth and transformation that are found there american cream is a tender and wise novel by a writer of unusual sensitivity and grace

this book explores the idea of home using feminist scholarship and ethnographically grounded readings of historical literary and cultural texts contributors interrogate the comfortable and stable contours of home and ask what it means to women in different social class sexual ethnic and racial contexts in different times and places giving voice to diverse women's understandings of home the book includes stories of elite white u.s. and canadian women rural poor and peasant white women in the united states and france a british caribbean freed slave woman and others

pecan springs hide complex and dangerous pasts and now while also unraveling secrets that hit close to home china must set the record straight and find a killer

this is the third book in the trilogy about lucy richards arnolds life in rural west texas in the early 20th century

the wartime diaries of fred lodge underscore his perilous passage through world war 2 including the dieppe raid and three years as a pow in germany fred was a quiet kind considerate and courageous young canadian who trained in canada as an infantry soldier practiced his military skills in england waded onshore at pourville france on august 19th 1942 survived intense german gunfire saw his buddies killed maimed indeed slaughtered somehow he survived that awful day at dieppe and was transported to stalag viiib and later to stalag iic in eastern germany as a pow he was often hungry bored shamed shackled witnessed summary executions and was forced to participate in a death march in early 1945 through it all fred lodge was courageous and true to his beliefs no matter what obstacles temptations or mistreatment came his way he always did his best and the right thing fred didn't hate germans although he had no respect for inhumane nazi zealots with the russian army fast approaching canadian pows were evacuated westwards in january 1945 in bone chilling cold and snow over four months they were marched west with little food no warm clothing little shelter and no reason to think they might survive however fred and most of his fellow pows did survive and in late april 1945 they were liberated and returned to england somehow fred lodge remained the same quiet kind considerate and courageous man he was at the beginning this story as told by fred lodge himself is a gripping tale he passed through the hell of war and emerged whole could you do the same

the fantastic other is a carefully assembled collection of essays on the increasingly significant question of alterity in modern fantasy the ways in which the understanding and construction of the other shapes both our art and our imagination the collection takes a unique perspective seeing alterity not merely as a social issue but as a biological one our fifteen essays cover the problems posed by the other which after all go well beyond the bounds of any single critical perspective with this in mind we have selected studies to show how insights from deconstruction marxism feminism and freudian jungian and evolutionary psychology help us understand an issue so central to the act of reading
