1922 now almost all deceased only a few were ever interviewed for other books barrier juxtaposes disney s own recollections against the memories of those other players to great effect what emerges is a portrait of walt disney as a flawed but fascinating artist one whose imaginative leaps allowed him to vault ahead of the competition and produce work that even today commands the attention of audiences worldwide
