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victimology and crime prevention are growing interrelated areas cutting across several disciplines victimology examines victims of all sorts of criminal activity from domestic abuse to street violence to victims in the workplace who lose jobs and pensions due to malfeasance by corporate executives crime prevention is an important companion to victimology because it offers insight and techniques to prevent situations that lead to crime and attempts to offer ideas and means for mitigating or minimizing the potential for victimization in many ways the two fields have developed along parallel yet separate paths and the literature on both has been scattered across disciplines as varied as sociology law and criminology public health and medicine political science and public policy

a team of educators counselors and scholars examine the widespread problem of sexual assault and abuse in the united states from a legal criminal justice psychological clinical and legislative perspective the statistics on sexual abuse in the united states suggest that such crimes are perceived as socially acceptable despite laws to the contrary thirty percent of women are battered at least once in their adult lives while four million girls and women are trafficked annually seventy five percent of employed battered women are harassed at their jobs by abusive husbands or lovers and half of them are murdered by these mates at least twenty percent of women have been victimized by incest victims of sexual assault and abuse serves as a reference guide for professionals working with victims and perpetrators topics addressed include assault within marriage courtship violence abducted and runaway youth violence against pregnant women cyberspace violence and sexual harassment of students and employees this multivolume set promotes legislation to break the cycles of violence and dispels myths about victims and perpetrators preventative programs policies and educational programs are emphasized

this book examines the assessment and obligatory treatment programs for violent and sexually violent offenders primarily adolescents and adults diagnosed with cluster b personality disorder or a conduct disorder it describes concepts theories and legal aspects as well as the psychological and neurobiological characteristics of violent and sexually violent offenders and forensic psychiatric patients chapters review treatment programs and provide guidelines for gathering additional information and formulating functional analyses to establish individual treatment plans in addition chapters offer treatment modules for violent offenders and sexually violent offenders and address specific problems that may be encountered in practice and how to overcome these problems the book concludes with the editors recommendations for future research in offender assessment and rehabilitation topics featured in this book include heuristic models of aggressive and sexually aggressive behavior the use of self reporting questionnaires in

offender populations reliable assessment instruments the effectiveness of existing rehabilitation programs cognitive behavioral treatment modules for violent and sexually violent offenders self regulation and self management skills to be used in rehabilitation programs facilitating treatment integrity in penitentiary and forensic psychiatric institutions assessment and obligatory treatment of violent and sexually violent offenders is an essential resource for researchers clinicians therapists and upper level undergraduate and graduate students in forensic psychology public health criminology criminal justice and behavioral therapy and rehabilitation

animal abuse as a predictor of abuse against humans has been documented extensively experts have explored alternatives to identify the early signs and stop the cycle this book offers an up to date compendium that covers the historical legal research and applied issues related to animal abuse and cruelty

factors play in male crime and violence the book also focuses on the correlation between male violence and aggressive behavior and firearms violence involving intimates male sexual violence bias crimes workplace violence terrorism male perpetrated sexual offenses youth gang crime and school violence these areas of male criminality and deviance are examined within the context of all male offending arrest self report and inmate data along with criminological theoretical approaches to understanding the causes and related factors of male deviant behavior the book is written primarily for undergraduate and graduate level students for coursework in criminal justice criminology male aggression violent behavior homicide youth studies gang studies delinquency law law enforcement sociology social science psychology biology and related areas of study however it is appropriate as well for academicians social scientists psychologists law officers medical workers and a general readership with a vested interest in antisocial behavior and its implications on the greater society
