kansas city was the location of his first film production studio laugh o gram films walt disney s missouri not only tells the story of the young disney growing up but it also paints a picture of the kansas city he knew with the bankruptcy of laugh o gram films disney moved to california drawing with him many of his kansas city colleagues who would eventually win fame in animation themselves this richly illustrated book describes disney s missouri years and chronicles his many connections and returns to the state until his death in 1966 the book also details two little know projects in missouri that disney seriously considered in his later years theme parks in his hometown marceline and in st louis as his daughter diane disney miller says in the foreword to the book walt disney was truly a missourian
