this book draws together the seminal contributions to the literature on the nature of macroeconomics in open economies and illuminates the material this is an essential guide to the subject for students

this paper tests uncovered interest parity UIP using interest rates on longer maturity bonds for the group of seven countries these long horizon regressions yield much more support for UIP all of the coefficients on interest differentials are of the correct sign and almost all are closer to the UIP value of unity than to zero the paper also analyzes the decision by a government facing electoral uncertainty to implement structural reforms in the presence of fiscal restraints similar to the stability and growth pact

we study a wide range of hybrid inflation targeting and managed exchange rate regimes analyzing their implications for inflation output and the exchange rate in the presence of various domestic and external shocks to this end we develop an open economy new Keynesian model featuring sterilized interventions in the foreign exchange FX market as an additional central bank instrument operating alongside the Taylor rule and affecting the economy through portfolio balance sheet effects in the financial sector we find that there can be advantages to combining it with some degree of exchange rate management via FX interventions unlike pure IT or exchange rate management via interest rates FX interventions can help insulate the economy against certain shocks especially shocks to international financial conditions however managing the exchange rate through FX interventions may also hinder necessary exchange rate adjustments e.g. in the presence of terms of trade shocks

provides a comprehensive survey of recent developments in international financial markets including developments in emerging capital markets bond markets major currency markets and derivative markets the report focuses on efforts by the major industrial countries to strengthen the management of financial risk and prudential oversight over the international banking system it also critically evaluates existing mechanisms for international cooperation of financial supervision and regulation and proposes the development of international banking standards

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
