that people place a higher value on immediate gratification compared to rewards received in the future even when those future rewards are objectively larger. This bias can lead to suboptimal outcomes such as procrastination, overconsumption, and inadequate savings. Laibson's research on hyperbolic discounting has implications for policy interventions aimed at promoting longterm wellbeing. For example, his findings suggest that policies that provide automatic enrollment in retirement savings plans or that make healthy food choices more readily available can help individuals overcome their shortterm biases and achieve their longterm goals.
