and inter regional mobility we find a surprisingly strong role for the institutions in the housing market somewhat stronger than other institutions and check the robustness of this result we then argue in part e that removing obstacles to geographical mobility and simultaneously undertaking pro competition reforms in the goods market could be a beneficial mix as these measures each reinforce the other s positive effect wage flexibility notably regional wage flexibility would also ease the convergence of labour markets but in a realistic short run this cannot be the only dimension of reform it requires social consensus on redefining fundamental elements of the european welfare states which is a long run target we focus on other reforms that can be implemented in a shorter time horizon
