drug politics is an enlightening new book by a man who knows this disturbing and dangerous subject a former united states ambassador to peru david c jordan has testified before the u s senate and house foreign relations committees and has consulted with various government security organizations his account of government protection of the criminal elements intertwined with local and global politics challenges many of the assumptions of current drug policies using examples from south america mexico russia and the united states jordan shows that the narcotics problem is not merely one of supply and

demand jordan argues that many national and international financial systems are dependent on cash from money laundering and some governments are far more involved in protecting than in combating criminal cartels

the most destructive force in the americas today is not el niño it is the criminal enterprises that recognize no geographic legal or moral boundaries this book exposes the main characteristics and effects of criminal enterprises in the americas and considers realistic strategies for combating them looking at how crime penetrates private business government and the everyday lives of the people this collection examines the impact of criminal enterprises on the legitimate economy and the ability of states to promote the rule of law it compares criminal enterprises in the americas with other regions and considers the foreign policy concerns of the us with a recent upsurge in the scope sophistication and cooperation among groups this book is essential tool for understanding one of the greatest challenges to security peace and democracy in the americas

illicit cross border flows such as the smuggling of drugs migrants weapons toxic waste and dirty money are proliferating on a global scale this underexplored clandestine side of globalization has emerged as an increasingly important source of conflict and cooperation among nation states state agents nonstate actors and international organizations contrary to scholars and policymakers who claim a general erosion of state power in the face of globalization this pathbreaking volume of original essays explores the selective nature of the states retreat persistence and reassertion in relation to the illicit global economy it fills a gap in the international political economy literature and offers a new and powerful lens through which to examine core issues of concern to international relations scholars the changing nature of states and markets the impact of globalization across place and issue areas and the sources of cooperation and conflict

mexico s democratic transition has created a competitive electoral system and a formally plural state besides a peculiar wave of insurgency started in 1994 has challenged the alleged moderating effect of democratic transition this book argues that socioeconomic inequality is the main factor behind this combination of democratic and undemocratic trends

does market liberalization promote democracy the accepted answer from scholars pundits and politicians alike has been yes however the contributors to this innovative study of market reforms and political change in mexico and the people s republic of china argue that this easy equation is not only empirically uncertain but methodologically flawed using comparative contextual analysis the contributors carefully identify the elective affinities between these two very different polities to reveal key variables that determine how markets will affect democracy particularly law as the rudder of democracy and the role of political culture in civil society

eclipse of the assassins investigates the sensational 1984 murder of mexico's most influential newspaper columnist manuel buendía and how that crime reveals the lethal hand of the u s government in mexico and central america during the final decades of the twentieth century

the signing of the north american free trade agreement nafta was expected to signal the beginning of a new era of close cooperation between mexico and the united states subsequent events however have introduced new tensions into the relationship the 1995 economic collapse in mexico sharply curtailed economic growth and lowered the demand for u s exports the result has been a substantial deficit in u s trade with mexico and renewed arguments that trade with mexico reduces the employment opportunities of low skilled workers in the united states immigration both legal and illegal has grown as a subject of contention between the two countries mexico has also come under increased focus as a conduit for the flow of drugs into the united states in this book scholars from the united states and mexico examine the major elements of the bilateral relationship the economic dimension is highlighted in two papers that focus on the effects of nafta on trade and financial transactions the political and social dimensions are taken up in three papers on immigration drug trafficking and environmental concerns the contributors include j enrique espinosa and pedro noyola sai consultores mexico john williamson institute for international economics juan carlos belauteguigoitia ministry of the environment mexico peter smith university of california san diego and george borjas harvard university

this provocative thoroughly researched book explores the covert aspects of u s foreign policy prominent political analyst peter dale scott marshals compelling evidence to expose the extensive growth of sanctioned but illicit violence in politics and state affairs especially when related to america's long standing involvement with the global drug traffic beginning with thailand in the 1950s americans have become inured to the cia's alliances with drug traffickers and their bankers to install and sustain right wing governments the pattern has repeated itself in laos vietnam italy mexico thailand nigeria venezuela colombia peru chile panama honduras turkey pakistan and now afghanistan to name only those countries dealt with in this book scott shows that the relationship of u s intelligence operators and agencies to the global drug traffic and to other international criminal networks deserves greater attention in the debate over the u s presence in afghanistan to date america's government and policies have done more to foster than to curtail the drug trade the so called war on terror and in particular the war in afghanistan constitutes only the latest chapter in this disturbing story

this book uncovers the activities of clandestine governments it explores how covert political activity and transnational organised crime are linked and how they ultimately work to the advantage of state and corporate power using a variety of case studies from the mafia in italy to programmes for food and reconstruction in iraq the authors illustrate that parapolitical structures are not deviant but central to the operation of global governments the creation of this parallel world economy the source of huge political and economic potential entices states to undertake new forms of regulation either through their own intelligence agencies or through the more shadowy world of criminal cartels

this dissertation identifies a case of emerging market failure represented by the mexican financial crisis of 1994 95 the hypothesis is that the financial crisis that occurred during the 1990s in mexico is linked to the one that took place during the 1980s and that both financial crises are manifestations of a single phenomenon the two financial crises are strung together by a thread that involves freely flowing international capital and an economy that is strongly reliant on the

international capital market this study finds that the principal explanation for both crises is located in the interaction of the following the fundamentals of the mexican economy that does not generate domestic savings and relies upon the international financial market a political system that concentrates power at the expense of the democratic political process and the governmental policies that pursue goals in the short run at the expense of long term outcomes
