In 2007 the complete *Persepolis* was published in a single volume combining *Persepolis 1* the story of a childhood and *Persepolis 2* the story of a return. Indeed, Marjane's mother slaps them both when they return home, as this was the day when so many people had died in one neighborhood that a rumor spread that it was Israeli soldiers who had attacked them, when indeed it had been their own who attacked. *Persepolis 1*, pg. 38-39. Things start to look up when the Shah finally leaves his post, overthrown by the 1979 Islamic Revolution, leading the whole country to rejoice.
