this dictionary of persian grammar has certain distinctive features that make it more informative and attractive than other sources on persian grammar every entry here begins with a thorough linguistic analysis according to the latest developments in the field followed by its literary usage which is an integral part of the language and culture the final part of the book deals with the developmental stages of acquiring persian as clear evidence for the origins of the linguistic descriptions the value of this dictionary lies in its use as a three tiered compilation that meets the needs and demands of both instructors of persian and students of persian language and linguistics

the basis for this additional volume are the three volumes of the handbooks dictionaries an international encyclopedia of lexicography hsk 5 1 5 3 published between 1989 and 1991 an updating has been perceived as an important desideratum for a considerable time in the present supplementary volume the premises and subjects of hsk 5 1 5 3 are complemented by new articles that take account of the practice internal and theoretical developments of the last 15 years special attention has been given to the following topics the status and function of lexicographic reference works the history of lexicography the theory of lexicography lexicographic processes lexicographic training and lexicographic institutions new metalexicographic methods electronic and especially computer assisted lexicography

pamir with the exception of persian other iranian languages had not received much attention in the past thus this work as the first volume ever published on various aspects of these languages and their linguistic properties is a valuable contribution to our understanding of a less commonly studied language family the theoretical descriptive and applied approaches pursued by various authors in this volume together with the colorful range of languages discussed provide a unique perspective that is appealing to researchers in different domains of linguistics and language studies
