one of the key issues in second language learning and teaching concerns the role and practice of grammar instruction does it make a difference how do we teach grammar in the language classroom is there an effective technique to teach grammar that is better than others while some linguists address these questions to develop a better understanding of how people acquire a grammar language acquisition scholars are in search of the most effective way to approach the teaching of grammar in the language classroom the individual chapters in this volume will explore a variety of approaches to grammar teaching and offer a list of principles and guidelines that those involved in language acquisition should consider to design and implement effective grammar tasks during their teaching it proposes that the key issue is not whether or not we should teach grammar but how we incorporate a teaching grammar component in our communicative language teaching practices

this volume consists of a collection of empirical studies and research syntheses investigating the role of individual difference id variables in task based language teaching tbtl a pedagogical approach that emphasizes the importance of the performance of meaning oriented tasks in facilitating second language learning tbtl is subject to learner external as well as learner internal factors with the former referring to task and context related factors and the latter to id factors pertaining to learner traits dispositions or propensities to date the research has focused primarily on learner external factors and there has been insufficient and unsystematic research on individual difference factors this volume brings centre stage this important but under researched dimension by means of a comprehensive in depth examination of the role of key id factors in tbtl the volume integrates theory research and pedagogy by spelling out the mechanism through which ids influence learning attainment behaviours and processes examining evidence for theoretical claims and discussing ways to apply research findings and cater to

individual differences in the task based classroom

the results of more than seventy years of investigation by factor analysis of the varieties of cognitive abilities are described with particular attention to abilities in language thinking memory visual and auditory perception creativity etc

are there evidence based answers to the broad question what explicit knowledge about language in teachers and or students appears to enhance literacy development in some way distinguished by its global perspective its currency and its comprehensiveness beyond the grammar wars provides an historical overview of the debates around grammar and english literacy teaching in four settings the us england scotland and australia offers an up to date account of what the research is telling and not telling us about the effectiveness of certain kinds of grammar based pedagogies in english literacy classrooms takes readers into english literacy classrooms through a range of examples of language grammar based pedagogies which have proven to be successful addresses metalinguistic issues related to changes in textual practices in a digital and multimodal age and explores the challenges for educators who are committed to finding a usable grammar to contribute to teaching and learning in relation to these practices all of the contributors are acknowledged experts in their field activities designed for use in language and literacy education courses actively engage students in reflecting on and applying the content in their own teaching contexts

this book highlights the grammatical structure of thought and behavior as a blueprint for scientific discovery and innovation it defines the new concept of metagrammar as the unnoticed transfer of linguistic functions and skills to and from our interaction with the world viewing grammar as language engineering the author argues that metagrammar charts a new mode of reasoning central to critical thinking problem solving and goal setting in all areas of human endeavor he shows how metagrammatical structures and genres mediate in the conceptualization of phenomena as well as in the production of plans policies systems and designs this uniquely human capability is contrasted with mechanistic models in computers and ai that threaten to replace human agency and decision making this book will be of interest to the educated reader who wants to keep abreast of transformational research in language and cognition as it applies to self and society current events digital media and emerging technologies from artificial intelligence to autonomous systems from a human centered perspective it will be particularly relevant to organizations such as the modern languages association for its focus on linguistic and narrative theory cultural studies and critical theory

second language learners differ in how successfully they adapt to and profit from instruction this book aims to show that adaptation to l2 instruction and subsequent l2 learning is a result of the interaction between learner characteristics and learning contexts describing and explaining these interactions is fundamentally important to theories of instructed sla and for effective l2 pedagogy this collection is the first to explore this important issue in contemporary task based immersion and communicative pedagogic settings in the first section leading experts in individual differences research describe recent advances in theories of intelligence l2 aptitude motivation anxiety and emotion and the relationship of native language abilities to l2 learning in the second section these theoretical insights are applied to empirical studies of individual differences treatment interactions in classroom learning experimental studies of the effects of focus on form and incidental learning and studies of naturalistic versus instructed sla

cognitive individual differences in second language processing and acquisition contains 14 chapters that focus on the role of cognitive ids in l2 learning and processing the book brings together theoretical and methodological approaches to the study of cognitive ids as well as empirical studies that investigate the mediating role of cognitive ids in various linguistic domains chapters include contributions from researchers working within second language acquisition sla psycholinguistics and cognitive psychology sharing a common interest in the application of cognitive ids to their respective areas of study the interdisciplinary understanding of cognitive ids presented in this book makes the book of interest to a wide readership of graduate students faculty members and academic researchers in the fields of sla psycholinguistics cognitive psychology and education

the routledge handbook of second language acquisition and individual differences provides a thorough in depth discussion of the theory research and pedagogy pertaining to the role individual difference id factors play in second language acquisition sla it goes beyond the traditional repertoire and includes 32 chapters covering a full spectrum of topics on learners cognitive conative affective and demographic sociocultural variation the volume examines ids from two perspectives one is how each id variable is associated with learning behaviors processes and outcomes the other is how each domain of sla such as vocabulary or reading is affected by clusters of id variables the volume also includes a section on the common methods used in id research including data elicitation instruments such as surveys interviews and psychometric testing as well as methods of data analysis such as structural equation modeling the book is a must read for any second language researcher or applied linguist interested in investigating the effects of ids on language learning and for any educator interested in taking account of learners individual differences to maximize the effects of second language instruction

this volume presents research on second language learning through audiovisual input conducted within the subtitl subtitles in language learning project at the university of barcelona it includes studies exploring various language dimensions and skills such as vocabulary pronunciation and reading while also considering learner factors such as language learning aptitude and proficiency two distinctive features
