greatest heliograph network ever built many of the officers who helmed these stations went on to distinguished careers in the military business or public service some had served in the civil war and most were veterans of the indian wars almost a third of these young officers would go on to become general officers several serving in leadership roles during world war i thus the heliograph not only connected points across the southwest but also linked a group of officers whose experience and leadership spanned from the civil war through world war i
