new york times bestseller the definitive account of one of the most accomplished controversial and polarizing figures in american history bill clinton is the most arresting leader of his generation he transformed american politics and his eight years as president spawned arguments that continue to resonate for all that has been written about this singular personality including clinton s own massive autobiography there has been no comprehensive nonpartisan overview of the clinton presidency few writers are as qualified and equipped to tackle this vast subject as the award winning veteran washington post correspondent john f harris who covered clinton for six of his eight years in office as long as any reporter for a major newspaper in the survivor harris frames the historical debate about president william jefferson clinton by revealing the inner workings of the clinton white house and providing the first objective analysis of

clinton s leadership and its consequences harris shows clinton entering the oval office in 1993 primed to make history but with the cold war recently concluded and the country coming off a nearly uninterrupted generation of republican presidents the new president s entry into this maelstrom of events was tumultuous his troubles were exacerbated by the habits personal contacts and the management style he had developed in his years as governor of arkansas clinton s enthusiasm and temper were legendary and he and hillary rodham clinton whose ambitions and ordeals also fill these pages arrived filled with mistrust about many of the characters who greeted them in the permanent washington that often holds the reins in the nation s capital showing surprising doggedness and a deep set desire to govern from the middle clinton repeatedly rose to the challenges eventually winning over or running over political adversaries on both sides of the aisle sometimes facing as much skepticism from fellow democrats as from his republican foes but as harris shows in his accounts of political debacles such as the attempted overhaul of health care clinton s frustrations in the war against terrorism and the numerous personal controversies that time and again threatened to consume his presidency bill clinton could never manage to outrun his tendency to favor conciliation over clarity or his own destructive appetites the survivor is the best kind of history a book filled with major revelations the tense dynamic of the clinton inner circle and clinton s professional symbiosis with al gore to the imprint of clinton s immense personality on domestic and foreign affairs as well as the minor details that leaven all great political narratives this long awaited synthesis of the dominant themes events and personalities of the clinton years will stand as the authoritative and lasting work on the clinton presidency

this book argues that we can learn a great deal about leadership from the experiences of eight us presidents who have served in the white house since watergate the eight presidents considered here differed widely in their family backgrounds wealth education age prior political experiences and motivations for power but they all made the same promise to faithfully execute the office of president of the us and preserve protect and defend the constitution of the united states and they all faced considerable challenges in fulfilling that promise while all eight presidents had policy successes and failures the author argues that we gain real insight on their leadership acumen by analyzing the deeper structures of leadership effectiveness that all leaders need to address vision execution management and decision making the book assesses the performance of each president along these four dimensions of leadership and extends lessons learned to leaders in other sectors

from nixon to clinton watergate to whitewater few americans have observed the ups and downs of presidential leadership more closely over the past thirty years than david

gergen a white house adviser to four presidents both republican and democrat he offers a vivid behind the scenes account of their struggles to exercise power and draws from them key lessons for leaders of the future gergen begins eyewitness to power with his reminiscence of being the thirty year old chief of the white house speechwriting team under richard nixon a young man at the center of the watergate storm he analyzes what made nixon strong and then brought him crashing down why nixon was the best global strategist among recent presidents how others may gain his strategic sense how nixon allowed his presidency to spin out of control why the demons within destroyed him what lessons there are in nixon s disaster gergen recounts how president ford recruited him to help shore up his white house as special counsel here gergen considers why ford is one of our most underrated presidents why his pardon of nixon was right on the merits but was so mishandled that it cost him his presidency even in his brief tenure ford offers lessons of leadership for others as gergen explains though gergen had worked in two campaigns against him ronald reagan called him back to the white house again where he served as the gipper s first director of communications here he describes how reagan succeeded where others have failed why his temperament was more important than his intelligence how he mastered relations with congress and the press the secrets of the great communicator and why his speeches were the most effective since those of john kennedy and franklin roosevelt in 1993 bill clinton surprised gergen and the political world when he recruited the veteran of republican white houses to join him as counselor after his early stumbles gergen reveals why clinton could have been one of our best presidents but fell short how the bill and hillary seesaw rocked the white house how failures to understand the past brought ken starr to the door why the new ways in which leadership was developed by the clinton white house hold out hope and what dangers they threaten as the twenty first century opens gergen argues a new golden age may be dawning in america but its realization will depend heavily upon the success of a new generation at the top drawing upon all his many experiences in the white house he offers seven key lessons for leaders of the future what they must have he says are inner mastery a central compelling purpose rooted in moral values a capacity to persuade skills in working within the system a fast start a strong effective team and a passion that inspires others to keep the flame alive eyewitness to power is a down to earth authoritative guide to leadership in the tradition of richard neustadt s presidential power and the modern presidents

in bill and hillary the politics of the personal the distinguished historian william h chafe boldly argues that the trajectory of the clintons political lives can be understood only through the prism of their personal relationship each experienced a difficult childhood bill had an abusive stepfather and his mother was in denial about the family s pathology he believed that his success as a public servant would redeem the family hillary grew up with an autocratic father and a self sacrificing mother whose most important lesson for her daughter was the necessity of family togetherness as an adolescent hillary s encounter with her youth minister helped set her moral compass on issues of race and social justice from the day they first met at yale law school bill and hillary were inseparable even though their relationship was inherently volatile the personal dynamic between them would go on to determine their political fates hillary was instrumental in bill s triumphs as arkansas s governor and saved his presidential candidacy in 1992 by standing with him during the gennifer flowers sex scandal he responded by delegating to her powers that no other first lady had ever exercised always tempestuous their relationship had as many lows as it did highs from near divorce to stunning electoral and political successes chafe s many insights into subjects such as health care kenneth starr welfare reform and the extent to which the lewinsky scandal finally freed hillary to become a politician in her own right and return to the consensus reformer she had been in college and law school add texture and depth to our understanding of the clintons experience together the latest book from one of our preeminent historians bill and hillary is the definitive account of the clintons relationship and its far reaching impact on american political life

americans constantly make moral judgments about presidents and foreign policy unfortunately many of these assessments are poorly thought through a president is either praised for the moral clarity of his statements or judged solely on the results of their actions in do morals matter joseph s nye jr one of the world s leading scholars of international relations provides a concise yet penetrating analysis of the role of ethics in us foreign policy during the american era after 1945 nye works through each presidency from fdr to trump and scores their foreign policy on three ethical dimensions of their intentions the means they used and the consequences of their decisions alongside this he also evaluates their leadership qualities elaborating on which approaches work and which ones do not regardless of a president s policy preference nye shows that each one was not fully constrained by the structure of the system and actually had choices he further notes the important ethical consequences of non actions such as truman s

willingness to accept stalemate in korea rather than use nuclear weapons since we so often apply moral reasoning to foreign policy nye suggests how to do it better most importantly presidents need to factor in both the political context and the availability of resources when deciding how to implement an ethical policy especially in a future international system that presents not only great power competition from china and russia but a host of transnational threats the illegal drug trade infectious diseases terrorism cybercrime and climate change

the american political science association political scientists are rarely able to study presidents from inside the white house while presidents are governing campaigning and delivering thousands of speeches it s even rarer to find one who manages to get officials such as political adviser karl rove or presidential counselor dan bartlett to discuss their strategies while those strategies are under construction but that is exactly what martha joynt kumar pulls off in her fascinating new book which draws on her first hand reporting interviewing and original scholarship to produce analyses of the media and communications operations of the past four administrations including chapters on george w bush and bill clinton kumar describes how today s white house communications and media operations can be at once in flux and remarkably stable over time she describes how the presidential press office that was once manned by a single presidential advisor evolved into a multilayered communications machine that employs hundreds of people what modern presidents seek to accomplish through their operations and how presidents measure what they get for their considerable efforts laced throughout with in depth statistics historical insights and you are there interviews with key white house staffers and journalists this indispensable and comprehensive dissection of presidential communications operations will be key reading for scholars of the white house researching the presidency political communications journalism and any other discipline where how and when one speaks is at least as important as what one says
