in his new book saints as they really are priest and scholar michael plekon traces the spiritual journeys of several american christians using their memoirs and other writings these saints in the making show all their doubts and imperfections as they reflect on their search for god and their efforts to lead holy lives they are gifted yet ordinary women and men trying to follow christ within their flawed and broken humanity saints as they really are as dorothy day put it saints as they really are is the third book in plekon s critically acclaimed series on saints and holiness in our time he draws on the autobiographical work of dorothy day peter berger thomas merton kathleen norris and barbara brown taylor among others as well as from his
