### Yin and Yang

This fundamental duality represents balance and harmony In architecture this translates to balancing light and shadow open and enclosed spaces and active and passive zones A welldesigned building integrates both stimulating and relaxing areas

## 2 Form and Shape Xng

The shape and form of a building significantly impact the flow of Qi Sharp angles can create disruptive energy

while smooth curves promote a gentler flow The use of organic shapes and natural materials can enhance the positive impact

## II Data Visualization and Practical Application

The impact of Feng Shui principles on architectural design can be visualized using different methods For instance a Bagua overlay on a floor plan Figure 1 shows how different areas of a house relate to life aspirations Quantitative data on occupant wellbeing eg stress levels productivity in buildings designed with and without Feng Shui principles could provide compelling evidence although such studies are currently limited
