in august 1929 from 1907 he settled in the small town of ottery st mary in rural east devon england
he was very active serving as a british delegate at the second hague peace conference in 1907 and
on various committees related to church missionary and other more local affairs he was a
magistrate and chairman of the urban district council he had a very wide social circle of family
friends and former colleagues with frequent distinguished visitors he produced two seminal books a
guide to diplomatic practice 1917 now in its seventh revised edition and referred to as satow and a
diplomat in japan 1921 the latter is highly evaluated as a rare foreigner s view of the years leading
to the meiji restoration of 1868 this book in two volumes is the last in a series of satow s diaries
edited by ian ruxton this is the first ever publication
