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L'analisi linguistica e letteraria è una rivista internazionale di linguistica e letteratura peer reviewed ha una prospettiva sia sincronica che diacronica e accoglie ricerche di natura teorica e applicata seguendo un orientamento spiccatamente interdisciplinare si propone di approfondire la comprensione dei processi di analisi testuale in ambito letterario come anche in ambito linguistico la rivista è organizzata in tre sezioni la prima contiene saggi e articoli la seconda presenta discussioni e analisi d'opera relative alle scienze linguistiche e letterarie la terza sezione ospita recensioni e una rassegna di brevi schede bibliografiche riguardanti la linguistica generale e le linguistiche delle singole lingue francese inglese russo tedesco la rivista pubblica regolarmente articoli in francese inglese italiano e tedesco e occasionalmente anche in altre lingue nel 2010 ad esempio ha pubblicato un volume tematico interamente in russo

perché soltanto pochi studenti raggiungono il livello b1 del quadro europeo delle lingue e la maggioranza di loro non supera il livello a2 manifestando una limitata capacità comunicativa questo semplice interrogativo fa riflettere sulla necessità dell'utilizzo di metodologie didattiche che accelerino e potenzino il processo di apprendimento dando a tutti l'opportunità di raggiungere in tempi rapidi una significativa padronanza linguistica il codice dell'apprendimento è un manuale di didattica delle lingue centrato sul concetto che l'apprendimento degli skills linguistici può essere notevolmente potenziato attraverso l'utilizzo del sistema cinestesico motorio la grande novità del libro è la combinazione tra il metodo total physical response lo storytelling role playing e simulazioni che concorrono a velocizzare i tempi di acquisizione delle lingue

this book presents a practical and easy to follow guide to develop and deliver an online language course successfully it provides language teachers across the globe with useful insights and strategies to effectively teach language online it offers suggestions on designing developing delivering and improving online courses and provides ideas on engaging and motivating students by making learning relevant to them the book focuses on the importance of collaborative and cooperative learning and empathy in improving students learning experience online while taking the reader through the essential steps of course development and delivery the text also shares the personal experiences that have helped the author develop some of her most successful teaching techniques for online courses

this book addresses the complexity of mixed language classroom learning environments in which heritage learners hl and second language l2 learners are concurrently exposed to language learning in the same physical space heritage speakers defined widely as those exposed to the target language at home from an early age tend to display higher oral proficiency and increased intercultural proficiency but lesser metalinguistic and grammatical awareness than l2 learners the theoretical and pedagogical challenges of engaging both types of learners simultaneously without polarizing the classroom community dictates the need for well defined differentiated learning strategies in response this book offers best practices and reproducible pedagogical initiatives and methodologies for different levels of instruction the chapters address themes including translanguaging linguistic identity metalinguistic awareness and intercultural competence with contributions from europe africa and the united states

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
