sycamore illinois christmas was three weeks away and seven year old maria ridulph went out to play soon after a figure emerged out of the falling snow he was very friendly minutes later maria vanished leaving behind an abandoned doll and footsteps in the snow in april a spring thaw gave up maria s body in a nearby wooded area the case attracted national attention including that of the fbi and president eisenhower in all seventy four men and three women fell under suspicion but no one was ever charged with the crime incredibly fifty five years later the coldest case in the history of american jurisprudence would be reopened it happened after a seventy four year old former neighbor of the ridulphs named eileen tessier made a stunning deathbed confession to her family about a dark past and a darker secret they knew nothing about two families would be joined by despair and retribution and in an astounding turn of events maria ridulph s killer would finally be brought to justice includes photographs
