philosophy challenges our assumptions especially when it comes to us from another culture in exploring japanese philosophy a dependable guide is essential the present volume written by a renowned authority on the subject offers readers a historical survey of japanese thought that is both comprehensive and comprehensible adhering to the japanese philosophical tradition of highlighting engagement over detachment thomas kasulis invites us to think with as well as about the japanese masters by offering ample examples innovative analogies thought experiments and jargon free explanations he assumes little previous knowledge and addresses themes aesthetics ethics the samurai code politics among others not in a vacuum but within the conditions of japan s cultural and intellectual history for readers new to japanese studies he provides a simplified guide to pronouncing japanese and a separate discussion of the language and how its syntax orthography and linguistic layers can serve the philosophical purposes of a skilled writer and subtle thinker for those familiar with the japanese cultural tradition but less so with philosophy kasulis clarifies philosophical expressions and problems western as well as japanese as they arise half of the book

s chapters are devoted to seven major thinkers who collectively represent the full range of japan s historical epochs and philosophical traditions kūkai shinran dōgen ogyū sorai motoori norinaga nishida kitarō and watsuji tetsurō nuanced details and analyses enable an engaged understanding of japanese buddhism confucianism shintō and modern academic philosophy other chapters supply social and cultural background including brief discussions of nearly a hundred other philosophical writers for additional information cross references to material in the companion volume *japanese philosophy a sourcebook* are included in his closing chapter kasulis reflects on lessons from japanese philosophy that enhance our understanding of philosophy itself he reminds us that philosophy in its original sense means loving wisdom not studying ideas in that regard a renewed appreciation of engaged knowing can play a critical role in the revitalization of philosophy in the west as well as the east

in this 1981 substantial work m j hambrey and w b harland have assembled essays by leaders in the field of pre pleistocene glacial research the work s various chapters review in depth the glacial records of africa antarctica asia australasia europe and north and south america

this study of more than two thousand years of african social history weaves together evidence from historical linguistics archaeology comparative ethnography oral tradition and art history to challenge the assumptions that all african societies were patriarchal and that the status of women in precolonial africa is beyond the scope of historical research in east central africa women played key roles in technological and economic developments during the long precolonial period female political leaders were as common as male rulers and women especially mothers were central to religious ceremonies and beliefs these conclusions contribute a new and critical element to our understanding of africa s precolonial history book jacket

this book places lion conservation and the relationship between people and lions both in historical context and in the context of the contemporary politics of conservation in africa the killing of cecil the lion in july 2015 brought such issues to the public s attention were lions threatened in the wild and what was the best form of conservation how best can lions be saved from extinction in the wild in africa amid rural poverty precarious livelihoods for local communities and an expanding human population this book traces man s relationship with lions through history from hominids to the romans through colonial occupation and independence to the present day it concludes with an examination of the current crisis of conservation and the conflict between western animal welfare concepts and sustainable development thrown into sharp focus by the killing of cecil the lion through this historical account keith somerville provides a coherent evidence based assessment of current human lion relations providing

context to the present situation this book will be of interest to students and scholars of environmental and african history wildlife conservation environmental management and political ecology as well as the general reader

intentionally excluded from formal politics in authoritarian states by reigning elites do the common people have concrete ways of achieving community objectives contrary to conventional wisdom this book demonstrates that they do focusing on the political life of the sha b or popular classes in cairo diane singerman shows how men and women develop creative and effective strategies to accomplish shared goals despite the dominant forces ranged against them starting at the household level in one densely populated neighborhood of cairo singerman examines communal patterns of allocation distribution and decision making combining the institutional focus of political science with the sensitivities of anthropology she uncovers a system of informal networks supported by an informal economy that constitutes another layer of collective institutions within egypt and allows excluded groups to pursue their interests avenues of participation traces this informal system from its grounding in the family to its influence on the larger polity discussing the role of these networks in meeting fundamental needs in the community such as earning a living reproducing the family saving and investing money and coping with the bureaucracy singerman demonstrates the surprising power these excluded people wield while the government has reduced politics to the realm of distribution to protect itself from challenges she argues that the popular classes in cairo as consumers of goods and services have turned exploiting the government into a fine art

christianity into the discussion the author puts forward his own interpretation of the qur anic revelation and in this volume primarily addresses its inclusiveness aspect by exploring how the qur an understands both inclusiveness and religion what islam is the book talking about is it one islam that around one fourth of the world s population follows are all of the commands in the qur an of eternal applicability did the qur an come with a new religion and how did the qur an define membership in the religion what impact did the qur an have on the beliefs and practices of those who accepted the revelation from the peoples of previous scriptures in the space time of the prophet yet as argued who at the same time maintained their religious identities this volume addresses these questions and a multitude of others this book is self contained it does not require the reader to have previous knowledge in any of the topics discussed the book discusses topics you do not find in your typical book about the qur an or islam it would interest those who want to learn about the qur an and its message among this group would be those searching for a reformed understanding of the qur an and how it applies today those curious to learn how the qur anic message affects followers of the previous revealed scriptures and those interested in monotheistic religions in general

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
