the art and life of Frida Kahlo have become the focus of intense admiration in the last ten years especially following the publication of Hayden Herrera's biography two films and a documentary have been made of her life Kahlo was a woman of extreme magnetism and originality an artist whose sensual vibrancy came straight from her own experiences her childhood near Mexico City during the Mexican Revolution her association through her husband Diego Rivera with the Communist Party her absorption in Mexican folklore and culture and her dramatic love of spectacle

an in depth biography of Mexican artist Frida Kahlo details her haunting and original painting style her turbulent marriage to muralist Diego Rivera her association with communism and her love of Mexican culture and folklore

the Sister Chapel 1974-78 was an important collaborative installation that materialized at the height of the women's art movement conceived as a nonhierarchical secular commemoration of female role

models the sister chapel consisted of an eighteen foot abstract ceiling that hung above a circular arrangement of eleven monumental canvases each depicting the standing figure of a heroic woman the choice of subject was left entirely to the creator of each work as a result the paintings formed a visually cohesive group without compromising the individuality of the artists contemporary and historical women deities and conceptual figures were portrayed by distinguished new york painters alice neel may stevens and sylvia sleigh as well as their accomplished but less prominent colleagues among the role models depicted were artemisia gentileschi frida kahlo betty friedan joan of arc and a female incarnation of god although last exhibited in 1980 the sister chapel has lingered in the minds of art historians who continue to note its significance as an exemplar of feminist collaboration based on previously unpublished archival materials and featuring dozens of rarely seen works of art this comprehensive study details the fascinating history of the sister chapel its constituent paintings and its ambitious creators

my painting carries within it the message of pain frida kahlo born in 1907 near mexico city learned about pain at a very early age she contracted polio at six and then at eighteen suffered serious and permanent injury to her right leg and pelvis in a terrible bus accident young and undaunted she went on to fall in love with the great mural painter diego rivera at a time when their native mexico was going through a period of thrilling political and cultural upheaval rivera and kahlo were a legendary couple both were impassioned lifelong communists while fervently attached to traditional mexican indian culture and both were driven by a relentless artistic ambition that surmounted all the dramas that plagued their marriage later frida became the friend and lover of leon trotsky she was greatly admired by the surrealists and sat for some of the greatest photographers of her day her art largely consisted of self portraits like the famous paintings the two fridas and the broken column though she also left many striking still lives in frida kahlo painting her own reality christina burrus assesses frida kahlo s extraordinary work a maelstrom of cruelty humor candor and insolence reflecting the essence of a free beautiful courageous woman who concealed her physical pain behind peals of infectious laughter

from the author of frida the moving and heroic story of one of the central painters of the twentieth century born in turkey around 1900 vosdanik adoian escaped the massacres of armenians in 1915 only to watch his mother die of starvation and his family scatter in their flight from the turks arriving in america in 1920 adoian invented the pseudonym arshile gorky and obliterated his past claiming to be a

distant cousin of the novelist Maxim Gorky he found work as an art teacher and undertook a program of rigorous study schooling himself in the modern painters he most admired especially Cézanne and Picasso by the early forties Gorky had entered his most fruitful period and developed the style that is seen as the link between European modernism and American abstract expressionism his masterpieces influenced the great generation of American painters in the late forties even as Gorky faced a series of personal catastrophes a studio fire cancer and a car accident that temporarily paralyzed his painting arm further demoralized by the dissolution of his seven year marriage Gorky hanged himself in 1948 a sympathetic sensitive account of artistic and personal triumph as well as tragedy Hayden Herrera's biography is the first to interpret Gorky's work in depth the result of more than three decades of scholarship and a lifelong engagement with Gorky's paintings Arshile Gorky traces the progress from apprentice to master of the man André Breton called the most important painter in American history
