long awaited much anticipated but let me ask the question have you been vaccinated because here comes an inoculation of truth guaranteed to immunize you

niggtivity proof niggativityis that deadly mental disease killing off the black community making us live like slaves even though we born free but exempt and liberated god will soon be god will soon be here comes that healing cupful of truth bitter to some but sweet to the true so pass the cup after you have drank the down and never again let evil hold the originals dow
