steam power armour guns and torpedoes today technological break throughs are centred around naval stealth and maritime propulsion systems special attention is devoted to the evolving state of naval technology showing how the relative industrial capabilities of seafaring countries have been reflected in their maritime building programmes providing an important link between the evolution of modern national fleets and the broader history of the period
