this book examines the impact of applying the terrorist label to a group's choice to resort to violence within an ethnonationalist conflict using the partiya karkerê kurdistanê pkk in turkey as a primary case study the book interrogates the socio political ramifications of the turkish government's decision to label the pkk as a terrorist organisation drawing on longitudinal interviews newly opened turkish and kurdish archives media frame databases and casualty logs it maps five decisive moments the 1984 guerrilla launch abdullah Öcalan's 1999 arrest the 2012 2015 peace talks kobani's stand against isis in 2015 in a town in syria and the 2025 stand down furthermore the study's empirical analysis and discussions reveal that the invocation of the label terrorist against the pkk places the group's actors and sympathisers in a situation that makes it harder for them to engage in peaceful means of resolving the conflict using four waves of interviews with kurds in turkey and syria spanning over a decade the book offers
