the story the acting edition contains notes showing how nearly all scene changes may be made with a minimum of effort people are inclined to laugh at joe a moody young italian with cockeyed notions at heart a musician he has a real talent for

a deep dive into racial politics hollywood and black cultural struggles for liberation as reflected in the extraordinary life and times of sammy davis jr through the lens of sammy davis jr s six decade career in show business from vaudeville to vegas to broadway hollywood and network tv dancing

down the barricades examines the workings of race in american culture the title phrase holds two contradictory meanings regarding davis s cultural politics did he dance the barricades down as he liked to think or did he simply dance down them as his more radical critics would have it davis was at once a pioneering barrier busting anti jim crow activist and someone who was widely associated with accommodationism and wannabe whiteness historian matthew frye jacobson attends to both threads analyzing how industry norms productions scripts roles and audience expectations and responses were all framed by race against the backdrop of a changing america in the spirit of better understanding davis s life and career dancing down the barricades examines the complexities of his constraints freedoms and choices for what they reveal about black history and american political culture

this wide ranging two volume encyclopedia of musicals old and new will captivate young fans and prove invaluable to those contemplating staging a musical production written with high school students in mind the world of musicals an encyclopedia of stage screen and song encompasses not only broadway and film musicals but also made for television musicals a genre that has been largely ignored the two volumes cover significant musicals in easily accessible entries that offer both useful information and fun facts each entry lists the work s writers composers directors choreographers and cast and includes a song list a synopsis and descriptions of the original production and important revivals or remakes biographical entries share the stories of some of the brightest and most celebrated talents in the business the encyclopedia will undoubtedly ignite and feed student interest in musical theatre at the same time it will prove a wonderful resource for teachers or community theatre directors charged with selecting and producing shows in fact anyone interested in theatre film television or music will be fascinated by the work s tantalizing bits of historical and theatre trivia

realism for the masses is an exploration of how the concept of realism entered mass culture and from there how it tried to remake america the literary and artistic creations of american realism are generally associated with the late nineteenth century but this book argues that the aesthetic actually saturated american culture in the 1930s and 1940s and that the left social movements of the period were in no small part responsible the book examines the prose of carlos bulosan and h t tsiang the photo essays of margaret bourke white in life magazine the bestsellers of erskine caldwell and margaret mitchell the boxing narratives of clifford odets richard wright nelson algren and the hollywood boxing film radio soap operas and the domestic dramas of lillian hellman and shirley graham and more these writers and artists infused realist aesthetics into american mass culture to an unprecedented degree and also built on a tradition of realism in order to inject influential definitions of the people into american popular entertainment central to this book is the relationship between these mass cultural realisms and emergent notions of pluralism significantly vials identifies three nascent pluralisms of the 1930s and 1940s the new deal pluralism of we re the people in the grapes of wrath the racially inclusive pluralism of vice president henry wallace s the people s century and the proto cold war pluralism of henry luce s the american century

the instant new york times bestseller one of people magazine s top 10 books of the year the rare celebrity memoir that s also a literary read as funny as it is reflective it shares stories behind pacino s hardscrabble upbringing classic films and journey to icon status people magazine from one of the most iconic actors in the history of film an astonishingly revelatory account of a creative life in full to the wider world al pacino exploded onto the scene like a supernova he landed his first leading role in the panic in needle park in 1971 and by 1975 he had starred in four movies the godfather and the godfather part ii serpico and dog day afternoon that were not just successes but landmarks in the history of film those performances became legendary and changed his life forever not since marlon brando and james dean in the late 1950s had an actor landed in the culture with such force but pacino was in his midthirties by then and had already lived several lives a fixture of avant garde theater in new york he had led a bohemian existence working odd jobs to support his craft he was raised by a fiercely loving but mentally unwell mother and her parents after his father left them when he was young but in a real sense he was raised by the streets of the south bronx and by the troop of buccaneering young friends he ran with whose spirits never left him after a teacher recognized his acting promise and pushed him toward new york s fabled high school of performing arts the die was cast in good times and bad in poverty and in wealth and in poverty again through pain and joy acting was his lifeline its community his tribe sonny boy is the memoir of a man who has nothing left to fear and nothing left to hide all the great roles the essential collaborations and the important relationships are given their full due as is the vexed marriage between creativity and commerce at the highest levels the book s golden thread however is the spirit of love and purpose love can fail you and you can be defeated in your ambitions the same lights that shine bright can also dim but al pacino was lucky enough to fall deeply in love with a craft before he had the foggiest idea of any of its earthly rewards and he never fell out of love that has made all the difference

schulberg among them the letters give us a unique grasp of his luminous insights on acting directing producing as he writes to and about marlon brando james dean warren beatty robert de niro boris aronson and sam spiegel among others we see kazan s heated dealings with studio moguls darryl zanuck and jack warner his principled resistance to film censorship and the upheavals of his testimony before the house committee on un american activities these letters record as well the inner life of the artist and the man we see his startling candor in writing to his first wife his confidante and adviser molly day thacher they did not mince words with each other and we see a father s letters to and about his children an extraordinary portrait of a complex intense monumentally talented man who engaged the political moral and artistic currents of the twentieth century

barbara stanwyck 1907 1990 rose from the ranks of chorus girl to become one of hollywood s most talented leading women and america s highest paid woman in the mid 1940s shuttled among foster homes as a child she took a number of low wage jobs while she determinedly made the connections that landed her in successful Broadway productions stanwyck then acted in a stream of high quality films from the 1930s through the 1950s directors such as cecil b demille fritz lang and frank capra treasured her particular magic a four time academy award nominee winner of three emmys and a golden globe she was honored with a lifetime achievement award by the academy dan callahan considers both stanwyck s life and her art exploring her seminal collaborations with capra in such great films as ladies of leisure the miracle woman and the bitter tea of general yen her pre code movies night nurse and baby face and her classic roles in stella dallas remember the night the lady eve and double indemnity after making more than eighty films in hollywood she revived her career by turning to television where her role in the 1960s series the big valley renewed her immense popularity callahan examines stanwyck s career in relation to the directors she worked with and the genres she worked in leading up

to her late career triumphs in two films directed by douglas sirk all i desire and there s always tomorrow and two outrageous westerns the furies and forty guns the book positions stanwyck where she belongs at the very top of her profession and offers a close sympathetic reading of her performances in all their range and complexity

william holden was a hollywood star whose career spanned four decades more than 70 films and three academy award nominations golden holden won an oscar for his role in stalag 17 and after films like sunset blvd he became one of hollywood s most powerful stars in the late 1950s his personal life included international adventures and romances with such stars as audrey hepburn and grace kelly yet he suffered from alcoholism and clinical depression this biography covers his entire life and career from boyhood through his greatest successes short decline re emergence in the wild bunch and his legacy of support for african wildlife
