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examines the overlap between film and philosophy in three distinct ways epistemological issues in film making and viewing aesthetic theory and film and film as a medium of philosophical expression

a fascinating look at hollywood's most turbulent decade and the demise of the studio system set against the boom of the post world war ii years the cold war and the atomic age and the movies that reflected the seismic shifts the definitive book on 1950s hollywood booklist lavish insightful rich expansive penetrating kirkus hollywood in the 1950s was a period when the film industry both set conventions and broke norms and traditions from cinerama cinemascope and vistavision to the epic film and lavish musical it was a decade that saw the rise of the anti hero the smoldering the hidden and the unspoken teenagers gone wild in the streets the sacred and the profane the revolution of the method the socially conscious the implosion of the studios the end of the production code and the invasion of the ultimate body snatcher the small screen television here is eisenhower's america seemingly complacent conformity ridden revealed in vincente minnelli's father of the bride walt disney's cinderella and brigadoon among others and here is its darkening resonant landscape beset by conflict discontent and anxiety the man who knew too much the asphalt jungle a place in the sun touch of evil it came from outer space an america on the verge of cultural political and sexual revolt busting up and breaking out east of eden from here to eternity on the waterfront sweet smell of success the wild one a streetcar named desire and jailhouse rock an important riveting look at our nation at its peak as a world power and at the political cultural sexual upheavals it endured reflected and explored in the quintessential american art form

steven spielberg has fashioned an enviable career as a writer producer and director of american motion pictures winning academy awards for best direction saving private ryan schindler's list and for best film schindler's list with david geffen and jeffrey katzenberg he founded dreamworks skg already one of the most productive and respected studios in hollywood despite spielberg's notable successes however his films have not avoided controversy the films of steven spielberg provides for the first time a collection of critical writings by professional film critics about the director and his films bringing together many articles and reviews scattered in often inaccessible specialist publications and professional journals the opinions vary from complimentary to critical but they definitely provide a well rounded view of the films and the director twelve of spielberg's major box office hits including jaws raiders of the lost ark e t the extra terrestrial the color purple empire of the sun jurassic park schindler's list amistad saving private ryan and close encounters of the third kind are discussed in essays that vary in complexity ranging from the heavily theoretical to the more general this collection of essays compiled for both film students and professionals in the film industry attests to the influence of spielberg and the films that have earned him a significant place in the history of cinema as one of america's most innovative and culturally important filmmakers

spanish filmmaker carlos saura who began his career under the censorship of franco's regime has forged an international reputation for his unique cinematic treatment of emotional and spiritual responses to repressive political conditions in films such as *carmen* and *el dorado* where reality and fantasy are deliberately fused together saura reveals the illusions of franco's mythologized spain a chaste catholic and heroic spain of the golden age that tend to isolate spaniards from the rest of europe from each other and from their own individuality in this first english language book on saura marvin d lugo looks at the social and artistic forces behind this film auteur's highly personal cinema tracing saura's career over three decades d lugo discusses each work from *hooligans* 1959 a realist film about a madrid street gang member trying to become a bullfighter to *the dark night* 1989 a film dealing with the persecution of the religious reformer st john of the cross in the late sixteenth century throughout he argues that saura's cinematic style results from a highly original response to the political and historical constraints of spanish culture d lugo shows how in order to explore the complex cultural politics of spanishness as it was institutionalized under franco saura frames his narrations through the eyes of characters who question the forces that shape personal and collective identity moving beyond the limits of traditional auteur studies this book addresses the relationship between the filmmaker and the cultural ideology that historically has thwarted and manipulated the expressions of individuality in spanish society

for almost 40 years japan's oshima nagisa has produced provocative films that have provided running commentary direct and indirect on the cultural and political tensions of postwar japan nagisa engages issues of sexuality and power and domination and identity which author maureen turim explores in relation to psychoanalytic and postmodern theory 66 photos

the new historical dictionary of the american film industry is a completely revised and updated edition of anthony slide's the american film industry originally published in 1986 and recipient of the american library association's outstanding reference book award for that year more than 200 new entries have been added and all original entries have been updated each entry is followed by a short bibliography as its predecessor the new dictionary is unique in that it is not a who's who of the industry but rather a what's what a dictionary of producing and releasing companies technical innovations industry terms studios genres color systems institutions and organizations etc more than 800 entries include everything from academy of motion pictures arts and sciences to zoom lens from astoria studios to zoetrope outstanding reference source american library association

since their beginnings in the 1930s hindi films and film songs have dominated indian public culture in india and have also made their presence felt strongly in many global contexts hindi film songs have been described on the one hand as highly standardized and on the other as highly eclectic anna morcom addresses many of the paradoxes eccentricities and myths of not just hindi film songs but also of hindi cinema by analysing film songs in cinematic context while the

presence of songs in hindi films is commonly dismissed as purely commercial this book demonstrates that in terms of the production process musical style and commercial life it is most powerfully the parent film that shapes and defines the film songs and their success rather than the other way round while they constitute india's still foremost genre of popular music film songs are also situational dramatic sequences inherently multi media in style and conception this book is uniquely grounded in detailed musical and visual analysis of hindi film songs song sequences and films as well as a wealth of ethnographic material from the hindi film and music industries its findings lead to highly novel ways of viewing hindi film songs their key role in hindi cinema and how this affects their wider life in india and across the globe it will be indispensable to scholars seeking to understand both hindi film songs and hindi cinema it also forms a major contribution to popular music popular culture film music studies and ethnomusicology tackling pertinent issues of cultural production multi media and the cross cultural use of music in hindi cinema the book caters for both music specialists as well as a wider audience

among asian countries where until recently documentary filmmaking was largely the domain of central governments japan was exceptional for the vigor of its nonfiction film industry and yet for all its aesthetic historical and political interest the japanese documentary remains little known and largely unstudied outside of japan this is the first english language study of the subject an enlightening close look at the first fifty years of documentary film theory and practice in japan

beginning with films made by foreigners in the nineteenth century and concluding with the first two films made after japan s surrender in 1945 abe mark nornes moves from a prehistory of the documentary through innovations of the proletarian film movement to the hardening of style and conventions that started with the manchurian incident films and continued through the pacific war nornes draws on a wide variety of archival sources including japanese studio records secret police reports government memos letters military tribunal testimonies and more to chart shifts in documentary style against developments in the history of modern japan
