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a considerable number of research studies have been conducted in order to suggest a professionally desirable and practically feasible definition of the school nurse's role yet the role of the school nurse remains unclear to both the lay public and the nursing profession the main purpose of this qualitative research was to define the role of school nurses from the perspective of the school nurse the social interaction model was used as a frame of reference for defining the role this model defines the role of the school nurse in terms of how the nurse interacts with other people in the educational environment this aspect of role definition has not been investigated in previous research studies a qualitative method multi case study was employed for the investigation of this issue study cases included 16 volunteer school nurses who work in benton clackamas lane linn and marion counties data were gathered from intensive interviews non participating observations and document reviews this study found that school nurses identified their major role as an advocate for students and their families regarding health related issues the school nurse's role also included acting as a resource person on health related issues for students families and all school personnel additionally the school nurse's role included working as a liaison between school districts schools students families community resources and local health departments the models of role interactions between school nurses and others were developed from analyzed data these models were depicted in illustrations time constraint because of over caseload was stated as the major factor that inhibits nurses from working more effectively being unable to spend enough time in each school leads to the problem of poor visibility for the school nurse and as a consequence causes poor role identity for the

nurse as well as unrealistic expectations for school nurses as perceived by students and school personnel study utilization and recommendations for further research were included

mental health is a growing challenge among children and adolescents in the u s schools are an ideal place to address this issue however consensus in addressing mental health in schools has yet to be reached with limited uniformity in programs mental health researchers have found that potential resources like school nurses are underused under recognized with their role misunderstood the purpose of this paper is to review the state of the science concerning school mental health programs and the role that school nurses could provide in mental health services to school age children methods included two search strategies using scopus pubmed and cinhal investigated the role of school nurses in mental health and school mental health programs a total of 32 articles were analyzed in an effort to clarify the role of the school nurse in mental health and how their success in this role can be facilitated results established that school mental health programs are successful particularly those using a collaborative whole school approach ideal however schools must overcome barriers of funding and mental health team limitations school nurses are highly capable of identifying referring intervening and educating about mental health and can lead collaborative efforts in school mental health barriers to school nurses using their mental health skills include lack of role clarity resources and education based on the literature review it was concluded that school mental health programs need to collaborate with community resources and focus on identification early intervention as well as treatment in a culturally competent manner the limitations of the mental health team and lack of resources negatively impact potential success changes in school nursing practice mental health parity

in nursing education and policies that prioritize the mental health of school children are needed
