applicability of the theory in the islamic setting in iium the study employed a quantitative research using survey method by using questionnaire as the research instrument pilot study was conducted to pre test the research instrument the data were collected from 240 undergraduate students of different departments under human sciences division of kulliyah of islamic revealed knowledge and human sciences kirkhs international islamic university malaysia iium using stratified random sampling based on department gender and nationality data were collected in april and may 2014 data were analyzed using spss version 20 for descriptive statistics and inferential statistics to achieve the objectives of the study and to test their hypotheses four general hypotheses and five specific hypotheses were generated in this study the finding proved that all factors were significantly correlated but majorities of the factors showed weak relationship the result showed that there was a similarity between motivation and hygiene factors in contributing towards learning satisfaction this indicated that the theory was not applicable on learning satisfaction as well as in the islamic setting since the findings rejected the general statement of the theory
