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the power and freedom of black feminist and womanist pedagogy still woke celebrates and reaffirms the power of black feminist and womanist pedagogies and practices in university classrooms employing autocritography through personal reflection research and critical analysis the contributors to the volume boldly tell groundbreaking stories of their teaching experiences and their evolving relationships to black feminist and womanist theory and criticism from their own unique perspectives each contributor views teaching as a life changing collaborative and interactive endeavor with students moreover each of them envisions their pedagogical practice as a strategic vehicle to transport the legacy of struggles for liberating social justice and transformative change in the u s and globally firmly grounded in black feminist and womanist theory and practice this book honors the herstorical labor of black women and women of color intellectual activists who have unapologetically held up the banner of freedom in academia

using the latest research real world examples and a new theory of healthy development this book explains hip hop culture s ongoing role in helping black

youths to live long healthy and productive lives in the healing power of hip hop raphael travis jr offers a passionate look into existing tensions aligned with hip hop and demonstrates the beneficial quality it can have empowering its audience his unique perspective takes hip hop out of the negative light and shows readers how hip hop has benefited the black community organized to first examine the social and historical framing of hip hop culture and black experiences in the united states the remainder of the book is dedicated to elaborating on consistent themes of excellence and well being in hip hop and examining evidence of new ambassadors of hip hop culture across professional disciplines the author uses research informed language and structures to help the reader fully understand how hip hop creates more pathways to health and learning for youth and communities

the essays in this book chart how women s profound and turbulent experiences of migration have been articulated in writing photography art and film as a whole the volume gives an impression of a wide range of migratory events from women s perspectives covering the caribbean diaspora refugees and slavery through the various lenses of politics and war love and family the contributors which include academics and artists offer both personal and critical points of view on the artistic and historical repositories of these experiences selfies motherhood violence and hollywood all feature in this substantial treasure trove of women s joy and suffering disaster and delight place memory and identity this collection appeals to artists and scholars of the humanities particularly within the social sciences though there is much to recommend it to creatives seeking inspiration or counsel on the issue of migratory experiences

this volume examines the use of black popular culture to engage reflect and parse social justice arguing that black popular culture is more than merely entertainment moving beyond a focus on identifying and categorizing cultural forms the authors examine black popular culture to understand how it engages social justice with attention to anti black racism black popular culture and social justice takes a systematic look at the role of music comic books literature film television and public art in shaping attitudes and fighting oppression examining the ways in which artists scholars and activists have engaged discussed promoted or supported social justice on issues of criminal justice reform racism sexism lgbtqia rights voting rights and human rights the book offers unique insights into the use of black popular culture as an agent for change this timely and insightful book will be of interest to students and scholars of race and media popular culture gender studies sociology political science and social justice

the sista network is a term used to describe the relationships between and among professional african american women which enable them to assist one another in learning the unwritten rules and protocols of various professions in the context of higher education the sista network can help new african american women faculty learn the rules to the tenure game a qualitative inquiry into the lives and experiences of nine african american women during various stages of the tenure process this book partly explores general practical considerations such as the tenure process requirements for tenure and negotiating the balance among teaching research service and collegiality yet it delves further into the statistics of african american women faculty in the academy issues of isolation mentoring and networking african american women faculty and the tenure process african american feminist thought and racism sexism and the politics of singularity also included are 12 guiding principles for new african american women faculty members embarking upon the tenure process carefully weaving african american feminist thought with the literature on academic tenure and minority along with stories of women faculty s experiences in the academy the

author creates an effective and engaging account for minority women embarking on the tenure journey themselves

this book has received the aesa american educational studies association critics choice award 2013 through ethnographically informed interviews and observations conducted with six black middle and high school girls hip hop s li l sistas speak explores how young women navigate the space of hip hop music and culture to form ideas concerning race body class inequality and privilege the thriving atmosphere of atlanta georgia serves as the background against which these youth consume hip hop and the book examines how the city s socially conservative politics urban gentrification race relations southern flavored hip hop music and culture and booming adult entertainment industry rest in their periphery intertwined within the girls exploration of hip hop and coming of age in atlanta the author shares her love for the culture struggles of being a queer educator and a black lesbian living and researching in the south and reimagining hip hop pedagogy for urban learners

through an in depth examination of the oral and written genres by and about women kolawole presents a comprehensive account of the african woman s role in forming and shaping cultural societal and political spheres

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
