afterward he referred to what he witnessed as the most bizarre and spectacular two events in the history of man's inhumanity to man from that first millionth of a second people began to die in previously unimaginable ways near Hiroshima's hypocenter teeth were scattered on the ground speckles of incandescent blood were converted to carbon steel a child's marbles melted to blobs of molten glass from the bombs were born radioactive substances that mimicked calcium in growing bones and which ten years later filled hospitals with a shocking truth nuclear weapons more than anything else were child killers based on years of forensic archaeology combined with interviews of more than two hundred survivors and their families *Ghosts of Hiroshima* is a you are there account of ordinary human beings thrust into extraordinary events during which our modern civilization entered its most challenging phase a nuclear adolescence that unless we are very wise and learn from our past we may not survive

the US decision to drop an atomic bomb on the Japanese city of Hiroshima on 6 August 1945 remains one of the most controversial events of the twentieth century however the controversy over the rights and wrongs of dropping the bomb has tended to obscure a number of fundamental and sobering truths about the development of this fearsome weapon the principle

of killing thousands of enemy civilians from the air was already well established by 1945 and had been practised on numerous occasions by both sides during the second world war moreover the bomb dropped on hiroshima was conceived and built by an international community of scientists not just by the americans other nations including japan and germany were also developing atomic bombs in the first half of the 1940s albeit haphazardly indeed it is difficult to imagine any combatant nation foregoing the use of the bomb during the war had it been able to obtain one the international team of scientists organized by the americans just got there first as this fascinating new history shows the bomb dropped by a us pilot that hot august morning in 1945 was in many ways the world s offspring in both a technological and a moral sense and it was the world that would have to face its consequences strategically diplomatically and culturally in the years ahead

the united states dropped atomic bombs on japan in 1945 to end world war ii as quickly and with as few casualties as possible that is the compelling and elegantly simple argument newman puts forward in his new study of world war ii s end truman and the hiroshima cult according to newman 1 the u s strategic bombing survey conclusions that japan was ready to surrender without the bomb are fraudulent 2 america s unconditional surrender doctrine did not significantly prolong the war and 3 president harry s truman s decision to use atomic weapons on japanese cities was not a racist act nor was it a calculated political maneuver to threaten joseph stalin s eastern hegemony simply stated newman argues that truman made a sensible military decision as commander in chief he was concerned with ending a devastating and costly war as quickly as possible and with saving millions of lives yet newman goes further in his discussion seeking the reasons why so much hostility has been generated by what happened in the skies over hiroshima and nagasaki in early august 1945 the source of discontent he concludes is a cult that has grown up in the united states since the 1960s it was weaned on the disillusionment spawned by concerns about a military industrial complex american duplicity and failure in the vietnam war and a mistrust of government following watergate the cult has a shrine a holy day a distinctive rhetoric of victimization various items of scripture and in japan support from a powerful marxist constituency as with other cults it is ahistorical newman declares its devotees elevate fugitive and unrepresentative events to cosmic status and most of all they believe newman s analysis goes to the heart of the process

by which scholars interpret historical events and raises disturbing issues about the way historians select and distort evidence about the past to suit special political agendas
