in *Phyllis Bottome's* compelling novel *The Victim and the Worm* readers are invited into a richly layered narrative that examines the complex interplay between victimhood and resilience. Painting sculpture literature architecture theatre cinema and music were all caught up in its net. Typography until then a distant relative in the arts also played a major role in Marinetti's program. Written by leading design scholar Alan Bartram this fascinating book examines the rise and evolution of the futurists approach to typography and graphic design placing it within the context of contemporary artistic and literary movements. The volume features examples of some eighty futurist books or other designs for print many of them relatively

unknown or previously unpublished accompanied by new translations of over twenty of the featured texts bartram illuminates the complicated meanings of the futurist designers graphic works in order to provide a new understanding of their extraordinary and influential visual language
