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reading my father is an intimate moving and beautifully written portrait of the novelist william styron by his daughter alexandra

in this ambitious and searching work cooper crafts a memoir that illuminates the enduring intersecting mysteries of family memory and identity

guardianship is golden in more ways than one it is more supreme than a power of attorney a power of attorney seems to be the correct way to assure your end of life accountings are in order majority of people complete the preparation for when their time comes some of us know little about guardianship you either learn from others or find yourself in an actual unfortunate experience power of attorney and guardianship are similar someone has control however there is

one huge difference if you have siblings and sometimes other family members in the picture once they are plagued with greed they can change everything our experience is a good example

by turning personal loss into a story of universal themes susan wicks poignantly speaks of the changes and concerns that children face as their parents grow older with a poetic touch and unflinching honesty her approach here is as unconventional as it is heartfelt when people asked me which of my parents i preferred i always said my father yet after an anguished call about her mother's death the author knew that her childhood days with her father behind the wheel of the car were gone with her father widowed and inconsolable their relationship becomes increasingly unsettled driving my father is a closer look at those changes a chronicle made up of glimpses brief episodes and a candid meditation on how father and daughter adapted to their new lifestyles book jacket title summary field provided by blackwell north america inc all rights reserved

vaibhav kulkarni has had few accomplishments worth boasting about in his modest life and career yet his happy universe lies intact in the love and pride his ten year old daughter inspires in him nisha kulkarni justifies every reason to be the favourite child of pune's premier school be it her academic brilliance her exceptional facility with music or simply her unassuming charm with his daughter showing promising signs of a stellar success story vaibhav has made peace with own unrequited dreams of the past but when the girl mysteriously starts losing mojo and spirals into despair and seclusion vaibhav faces the toughest test of his life as single father to reclaim his child's trust and happiness what distance will a middle class man with limited means go to show his daughter the merit in believing in a dream read this gripping tale of love courage and of the emergence of an ordinary man as an extraordinary hero

song for my father dramatises the complex losses in the life of a child whose parents fail to protect her from their own rage and sense of failure the novel s rhythms are at times deliberately fragmented and halting mirroring the broken and hesitant spirit of its narrator helpless in the face of her parents battles sarah turns to fantasy for escape their persistent conflicts however continue to shape her responses to life as an adult she unconsciously engineers the collapse of any chance for personal happiness ironically it is a sudden mysterious and traumatic disappearance which saves the protagonist this major crisis proves to be the catalyst for a liberating epiphany and healing catharsis and the final flight from darkness

written by author and speaker shawn seah my father s kampung delves into the social history of aukang and punggol as it traces a son s journey to better understand and appreciate the kampung life his father lived the book is rich in personal stories and oral histories of those who lived there from the 1940s to 1970s brought to life by seah s passionate narrative as well as illustrations and photos this book is supported by the national heritage board with forewords by robert yeo and montfort alumni

vanessa collins has known her life s destiny since she was a child now as an adult vanessa is on the verge of fulfilling the very purpose for which she was created before she can carry out this purpose god creates events that cause her to deal with her deceased father s ideologies her older brother s huge sense of

entitlement and the biggest test of all facing her own faults and insecurities

paul vrolijk recalls the last two months of his father's life and the two months that followed his funeral in farewell to my father his experience included the emptying and selling of a family home that had been in the family for half a century the book serves as a touching account of familial love memories from youth doubt and faith god's love and faithfulness working in and through all things and the love and care of a village community moreover it's a celebration of gratitude the author's story encourages readers to think about what it means to die well as well as what needs to be said and done when someone comes to the end of their life it also serves as a helpful guide on what to expect if you're preparing for the death of a loved one the book serves as a bold proclamation that nothing can separate us from the love of god in fact god is always working even amid suffering dying and all the practical details that must be considered when someone dies
