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first published in 1991 mongolia today presents a collection of essays by leading scholars in the field and gives important insights into the economic political legal and military systems of mongolia the mongolian people s republic formerly known as outer mongolia is three times the size of france but has population of just two million sandwiched between russia and china this remote heartland of asia has long been one of the most inaccessible places in the world its isolation preserved by political as well as geographical barriers the modern history of mongolia has been dominated by its two great neighbours strong economic and political ties with the erstwhile soviet union and problematic relations with china relations with the west have been slow to develop post cold war mongolia is willing to explore new relationships with other parts of the world and transform this once isolated land into a trading partner of international potential this is an essential read for scholars and researchers of central asian studies asian politics and chinese studies

the first analysis in russian international legal doctrine of the legal status of the waters surrounding the spitsbergen archipelago together with a consideration of the land territories of the various islands and related hydrocarbon and marine bioresource issues relevant international legal documents and diplomatic correspondence including a number previously unpublished are appended together with four maps and charts of the areas concerned the authors are experienced arctic and law of the sea specialists professor vylegzhanin is the director of the center for legal problems of the council of productive forces of the russian academy of sciences professor zilanov is an experienced diplomat in arctic matters who has headed a number of russian delegations for negotiations with norway over marine bioresources this translation has been edited and translated by william e butler john edward fowler distinguished professor of law dickinson school of law pennsylvania state university

bringing together a group of internationally renowned theorists these 9 essays asks whether there has been an ethical turn in butler's work exploring how ethics relate to politics and how they connect to her increasing concern with violence

this volume presents an analysis of the maritime boundary delimitations of the russian federation the focus of this analysis is the relationship between state practice and the rules of public international law applicable to the delimitation of maritime zones between neighboring states a first part establishes the contents of the law in this field the main part of the work concerns an analysis of the position of the russian federation on the rules of maritime delimitation law and the practice of this state in relation to the delimitation of specific maritime boundaries with neighboring states the case study of the russian federation illustrates the significance of international law for the delimitation of maritime boundaries while at the same time indicating the limits of the influence of the law on state behavior

lawler examines debates surrounding identity and shows how identity is part of the fabric of society and integral to social relations the book includes all the core topics covered by courses in this field and uses rich and varied contemporary empirical examples to illustrate the discussion

offers a new interpretation of butler's theology and suggests that exploration of his methods may contribute to modern thinking about ethics language the church as well as religion and science joseph butler 1692-1752 is perhaps britain's most powerful and original moral philosopher he exercised a profound influence over the contemporary protestant churches the english moralists and the scottish philosophical school but his

theory of the affections grounded in newtonian metaphysics and presenting an account of human psychology also set the terms of engagement with questions of education slavery missions and even labour relations in the nineteenth century english speaking world he was an authority of first resort for evangelicals tractarians philosophers scientists psychologists economists sociologists lawyers and educationalists alike he remains a key reference point for modern american and british philosophers from broad to rawls and beyond many analyses of butler however have been distorted by aggressively secular readings this book is based on a comprehensive reassessment of his published work and the surviving manuscripts and archival materials these are set within an account of his spiritual and intellectual development and his ministerial vocation from the protracted and painful process of conforming to the church of england to his initial observations on a social philosophy demonstrating that even the analogy originated in liturgical preaching this book offers a refreshed and detailed account of butler s key terms conscience consciousness identity affections charity analogy probability tendency and suggests that exploration of his methods may contribute to modern thinking about ethics language the role of the church and the religion and science debates bob tennant taught english literature at the university of sussex spent many years as a senior manager in adult education and was a trade union and political activist serving leading organisations at local regional and national levels he has written on political economic and trade union matters for many newspapers and periodicals and is a founder of the british pulpit online seeking to create an online catalogue and database of all printed british sermons from 1660 to 1901

judith butler has been arguably the most important gender theorist of the past twenty years this edited volume draws leading international political theorists into dialogue with her political theory each chapter is written by an acclaimed political theorist and concentrates on a particular aspect of butler s work the book is divided into five sections which reflect the interdisciplinary nature of butler s work and activism

butler and philosophy explores butler's unique relationship to the discipline of philosophy considering her work in light of its philosophical contributions butler and subjectivity covers the vexed question of subjectivity with which butler has engaged throughout her published history butler and gender considers the most problematic area gender taken by many to be primary to butler's work butler and democracy engages with butler's significant contribution to the literature of radical democracy and to the central political issues faced by our post cold war butler and action focuses directly on the question of political agency and political action in butler's work along with its companion volume judith butler and political theory it marks an intellectual event for political theory with major implications for feminism women's studies gender studies cultural studies lesbian and gay studies queer theory and anyone with a critical interest in contemporary american great power politics

this is an open access title available under the terms of a cc by nc nd 4.0 international licence it is free to read on the oxford academic platform and offered as a free pdf download from oup and selected open access locations this book addresses a simple question how do russians understand international law is it the same understanding as in the west or is it in some ways different and if so why it answers these questions by drawing on from three different yet closely interconnected perspectives history theory and recent state practice the work uses comparative international law as starting point and argues that in order to understand post soviet russia's state and scholarly approaches to international law one should take into account the history of ideas in russia to an extent russian understandings of international law differ from what is considered the mainstream in the west one specific feature of this book is that it goes inside the language of international law as it is spoken and discussed in post soviet russia especially the scholarly literature in the russian language and relates this literature to the history of international law as discipline in russia recent state practice such as the annexation of crimea in 2014 russia's record in the un security council the jurisprudence of the european court of human rights prominent cases in investor state arbitration and the creation of the eur asian economic

union are laid out and discussed in the context of increasingly popular civilizational ideas the claim that russia is a unique civilization and therefore not part of the west the implications of this claim for the future of international law its universality and regionalism are discussed
