alongside the scores of travel books about china written by foreign visitors chinese travelers impressions of their own country rarely appear in translation this anthology is the only comprehensive collection in english of chinese travel writing from the first century a d through the nineteenth early examples of the genre describe sites important for their geography history and role in cultural mythology but by the t ang dynasty in the mid eighth century certain historiographical and poetic discourses converged to form the travel account yu chi and later the travel diary jih chi as vehicles of personal expression and autobiography these first person narratives provide rich material for understanding the attitudes of chinese literati toward place nature politics and the self the anthology is abundantly illustrated with paintings portraits maps and drawings each selection is meticulously translated carefully annotated and

sir john betjeman 1906 1984 poet laureate was probably the most widely read english poet of the twentieth century because of his frequent appearances on radio and television and his fervent devotion to the preservation of england's architectural heritage his face and voice became familiar to millions few other poets of any century have had such a powerful influence on their contemporaries this bibliography lists and describes all of his known writings including his own books ephemera contributions to periodicals and to books by others lectures and radio and television programmes other categories such as editorships music settings and dramatic adaptations of his poems recordings and interviews are also included as well as a section devoted to writings about him manuscripts and drafts of all his works are described in detail this enormous body of material is thoroughly indexed cross referenced and in most cases annotated now at last the activities of this remarkable man both a poet and a cultural phenomenon can be seen in their full breadth and complexity

in the 1830s decades before darwin published the origin of species a museum of evolution flourished in london reign of the beast pieces together the extraordinary story of this lost working man's institution and its enigmatic owner the wine merchant w d saull a financial backer of the anti clerical richard carlile the devil's chaplain robert taylor and socialist robert owen saull outraged polite society by putting humanity's ape ancestry on display he weaponized his museum fossils and empowered artisans with a knowledge of deep geological time that undermined the creationist base of the anglican state his geology museum called the biggest in britain housed over 20 000 fossils including famous dinosaurs saull was indicted for blasphemy and reviled during his lifetime after his death in 1855 his museum was demolished and he was expunged from the collective memory now multi award winning author adrian desmond undertakes a thorough reading of home office spy reports and subversive street prints to re establish saull's pivotal place at the intersection of the history of geology atheism socialism and working class radicalism

in may of 1985 an international symposium was held at the metropolitan museum of art in honor of john m crawford jr whose gifts of chinese calligraphy and painting have constituted a significant addition to the museum's holdings over a three day period senior scholars from china japan taiwan europe and the united states expressed a wide range of perspectives on an issue central to the history of chinese visual aesthetics the relationships between poetry calligraphy and painting the practice of integrating the three art

forms known as san chieh or the three perfections in one work of art emerged during the sung and yuan dynasties largely in the context of literati culture and it has stimulated lively critical discussion ever since this publication contains twenty three essays based on the papers presented at the crawford symposium grouped by subject matter in a roughly chronological order these essays reflect research on topics spanning two millennia of chinese history the result is an interdisciplinary exploration of the complex set of relationships between words and images by art historians literary historians and scholars of calligraphy their findings provide us with a new level of understanding of this rich and complicated subject and suggest further directions for the study of chinese art history the essays are accompanied by 255 illustrations some of which reproduce works rarely published chinese characters have been provided throughout the text for artists names terms titles of works of art and literature and important historical figures as well as for excerpts of selected poetry and prose a chronology also containing chinese characters and an extensive index contribute to making this book illuminating and invaluable to both the specialist and the layman

this richly illustrated volume documents the art and fully examines the career of the sixteenth century chinese master tang yin one of the four great painters of the middle ming period the ambitious tang yin rose above the merchant class into which he was born to become a member of the elite scholarly circle in the city of suchou deprived by accident of his academic degrees and so forced to paint for a living tang yin became a social anomaly whose style of life cut across the conventions of his time his experiences throw into sharp relief the realities faced by a chinese painter who was both elite confucian scholar and professional painter anne de coursey clapp s work also explores larger issues of ming painting raised by the artist s turbulent career she describes the social and intellectual values exalted in ming suchou its system of patronage the contrast between the professional and amateur artist and the formative influence of twelfth century sung dynasty styles on suchou painters clapp shows how tang yin s artistic inventions were made in the course of leading the revival of sung dynasty styles in suchou tracing tang yin s early studies of ancient and contemporary masters she describes how he reworked an antique style converting it into a vehicle of expression that reached fruition in a long series of fresh and powerful paintings of landscapes and birds and flowers in the process she revises the distorted version of middle ming painting written by later chinese art theorists to justify their own social and artistic values noting especially the role of art patrons and their effect on artistic production clapp analyzes the increasing currency of painting as a means of social exchange in ancient china in particular she identifies commemorative painting as a major genre of the later dynasties and explores the role it played in the oeuvres of professional masters with its humanistic implications for the chinese view of the ideal scholarly man her broad view of tang yin s career shows him divided between the professional and amateur camps of his time in landscape and figural subjects he was aligned with the professionals in flower subjects with the amateurs clapp argues that the uneven distribution of styles and genres between this master who was subject to the market and those who were independent of it suggests that tang deliberately tried to expand the range of his paintings in order to appeal to buyers in the lower educational and social strata illustrated by some of

the most celebrated paintings and by some which are published for the first time her work is of tremendous importance to art literary and cultural historians of Ming China in this important work Anne de Coursey Clapp has drawn a clear picture of the patronage relationships and contribution to the history of Chinese painting in the person of Tang Yin she has chosen an ideal focus around which to examine some of the misleading stereotypes which have distorted our understanding of Chinese painting since the seventeenth century marked by analytical clarity and scrupulous scholarship her work is a welcome addition to the few works in English on individual Chinese artists Louise Yuhas Occidental College
