water as the likely cause of cholera in an 1854 outbreak in the same year the use of contaminated canal water in local water works caused a minor outbreak at ystalyfera in south wales workers associated with the company and their families were most affected and 119 died in 1867 italy lost 113 000 to cholera and 80 000 died of the disease in algeria outbreaks in north america in the 1870s killed some 50 000 americans as cholera spread from new orleans via passengers along the mississippi river and to ports on its tributaries
