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at the time of its first appearance in 1985 between men was viewed as an important intervention into feminist as well as gay and lesbian studies it was an important book because it argued that sexuality and desire were not a historical phenomenon but carefully managed social constructs this insight that actually originated with michael foucault is often viewed as anti humanist or post humanist because it argues that men and women are simply the products of patriarchal power relations over which they have no control by mobilizing foucault s theories of the history of sexuality sedgwick re fashions feminism and gay and lesbian studies to make it seem as though feminism and gay and lesbian studies are ideally situated to continue those interventions into the history of sexuality begun by foucault

this book focuses on the construction of hegemonic masculinity as well as its representations in literature culture and film although white heterosexual masculinity continues to be the dominant model it remains paradoxically largely invisible in gender terms while the first three chapters thus offer introductory theoretical perspectives on the latest research on white masculinities the following chapters concentrate on applying masculinity theory to the analysis of both social constructions and cultural i e literary and film representations of men s emotions with a special focus on new fatherhood models friendships between men as well as gender based violence

this text is the first to provide a contextual understanding of the clinical issues that affect men and masculinity across a wide range of cultural and national settings it demonstrates that gender can no longer be viewed as an isolated
