this excellent compilation of lorca s poetry and prose emphasizes lorca s notion of the duende the earth spirit of irrationality and death

having pursued a conventional enough path through school and university jason webster was all set to enter the world of academe as a profession but when his aloof florentine girlfriend of some years dumped him unceremoniously he found himself at a crossroads abandoning the world of libraries and the future he had always imagined for himself he headed off instead for spain in search of duende the intense emotional state part ecstasy part desperation so intrinsic to flamenco duende is an account of his years spent in spain feeding his obsessive interest in flamenco he subjects himself to the tyranny of his guitar teacher practising for hours on end until his fingers bleed he becomes involved in a passionate affair with lola a flamenco dancer and older woman married to the gun toting vicente only to flee alicante in fear of his life in madrid he falls in with gypsies and meets the imperious jes s joining their dislocated cocaine fuelled world stealing cars by night and sleeping away the days in tawdry rooms he finds himself sp

destructively downwards it is only when he arrives in granada bruised and battered after two years total immersion in the flamenco lifestyle that he is able to put his obsession into context in the tradition of laurie lee s classic *as i walked out* one midsummer morning duende charts a young man s emotional coming of age and offers real insight into the passionate essence of flamenco

this book explores the world of the french artist dominique gonzalez foerster through lavish visual material as well as essays by ina blom professor at the university of oslo norway penelope curtis curator at the henry moore institute leeds uk jens hoffman director of wattis institute for contemporary arts san francisco usa and lisette lagnado curator and artistic director of the 27th edition of the s□o paulo biennale also featuring an interview on literary creation with the writer enrique vila matas conducted by the artist herself along with hans ulrich obrist co director of the serpentine gallery london uk

stilettoed roses bleed is stephany stiletto rose s first collection of poetry highly autobiographical each poem provides a glimpses into what it means for a rose to grow stilettoed from the perspective of this southside chicago native with a voice that is unapologetically honest stephany rose provides her audience to embrace a wealth of compelling emotions

in six essays poet and novelist anne simpson traces the paths of her thoughts from observation to association through poetry language and metaphor otherness and wilderness walking the beaches and trails near her home in antigonish nova scotia simpson studies the connections between outdoors and inner life a hike along a local ridge and the sighting of an owl spurs an examination of birdsong and its kinship with poetry whose own perch is somewhere near the edge of grammar beyond sure knowledge where resonance and insight take the place of certainty what thoreau called tawny grammar following the owl simpson takes us to the underworld also home to otherness and to the spanish concept of duende the imminent presence of death in life in the work of other artists matthias grunewald s isenheim altarpiece elizabeth bishop s poetry and lesser known visual art and the fiction of nabokov borges and dostoevsky simpson ponders the location of the other in what is presented as subject for in this impasse between what readers and viewers and even the subjects themselves see and cannot see resides the death in life the wilderness on the edge of grammar along the way simpson shares some of her own poetic process the final piece in the collection recounts attempts to write poetry in response to a friend s photographs simpson writes of missteps and her eventual decision to abandon grammar in an effort to move closer to the emptiness that form illuminates and that illuminates form this consideration of form takes on board the buddhist teachings found in the heart sutra the commitment and responsibility we have to imagine what we are not here then is the other that compels the poet to write to occupy a place on the outside edge of onself this book is a kind of wild walking simpson says because as i was writing it my thinking became a little wild brambly and overgrown a kind of elderberry bush the walking and writing became almost indistinguishable i d be busy turning something over in my mind imagining a world without grammar for instance while

walking in the woods at the fairmont ridge and be startled out of it by the drumming of a ruffed grouse in winter walking across ice i began thinking that the descents and ascents of poetry were like those of the shamanic journey and why was poetry so intimately concerned with suffering did it reveal voyeurism or a depth of care these essays range around nova scotia as i kept returning to the way this province has become the home of my thinking not just the place where i live the final essay which seemed to grow out of the marram grass along the barrier beaches of the northumberland strait traces the connection between the heart sutra and poetry i guess the real question in each of these essays is the way writing depends upon otherness and how it arcs toward a relationship with the other

literary texts the arts s sixteen essays explore numerous aspects of both the theoretical and applied relationships between textuality in the form of novels plays and poems and visuality in the form of the photographic artistic or cinematic image topics range from the linguistic and artistic attempts to express the inexpressible or the transcendent in notions of the sublime where the essence of phenomena eludes the communicative and epistemological capacity of words and images to postmodern representations of time and cinematic adaptations of literary texts the photographic image is also examined as autonomous language that stands in opposition to the verbal and the written text and as a complementary mode that shares some communicative structures and modalities with the word while not being reducible to it the thread that runs through all of the essays is the assertion of the constructive or power of the word spoken recited written and the image representational mimetic nonrepresentational to create meanings as well as the implication that somehow that capacity is partial because it is limited by the inherent nature of the means of expression

the author poses that loneliness does not only consist of the heartfelt absences of a friend partner spouse or child but rather stems from a radical breach in one s life journey she develops a philosophy of receptivity and a portrait of redemptive suffering by fully exploring notions of pain she also examines how the relation between the heart s musical attunement and meaning filled life passages can lead one to a more spiritual philosophy and a more independent life
