roth's book is useful and valuable using modern secular thought as his starting point he reaches roughly the same conclusions that one would reach reasoning from the older christian tradition there is certainly much to like about that effort paul a cleveland markets morality this book is one of the best discussions of welfare economics since murray rothbard's classic paper of 1956 toward a reconstruction of utility and welfare economics david gordon the mises review timothy roth shows that social welfare theory as currently defended by welfare economists and policymakers is based on a confused and untenable moral theory is incompatible with a rights based legal order and is bound to promote unjust and arbitrary redistributions by advocating a return to the kantian conception of the moral agent roth shows the way to a normative economics that harmonizes with both intuitive morality and the american legal and constitutional tradition roger scruton writer and philosopher formerly university professor and professor of philosophy at boston university us the moral imperative of individual autonomy embodied in the kantian rawlsian perspective on social order cannot be reconciled with the utilitarian presuppositions that inform normative applications of modern economics this book exposes the contradictions that are present when the basic philosophical foundations are ignored a stance that is unfortunately characteristic of much modern discourse as well as political practice james m buchanan george mason university us and a nobel laureate at a time when technical economics dominates the thinking of much of the profession it is important to be reminded that economics has roots in moral philosophy certainly this book which deftly explores the ethical prior commitments underlying economic analysis succeeds in bringing philosophical issues to the forefront but it does more roth's closely reasoned study

provides a clear exposition of the kantian rawlsian approach to public policy and thus is able to establish a convincing critique of orthodox welfare theory in general the book offers a valuable change of perspective on social questions eirik g furubotn texas a m university us because it is technically flawed and morally bankrupt the author argues the economist s consequence based procedurally detached theory of the state has contributed to the growth of government as part of the kantian rawlsian contractarian project this book seeks to return economics to its foundations in moral philosophy given the moral equivalence of persons the greatest possible equal participation must be promoted persons must be impartially treated and because it is grounded in consequentialist social welfare theory swt the economist s theory of the state must be rejected ad hoc deployment of swt has facilitated discriminatory rent seeking and contributed to larger government in contrast this book argues that equal political participation and a constitutional impartiality constraint minimize rent seeking respect individual perceptions of the public good and underwrite the legitimacy of government economists moral philosophers and political scientists will find this book a unique contribution to the literature

historical materialism is what is called a fashionable subject the theory came into being fifty years ago and for a time remained obscure and limited but during the last six or seven years it has rapidly attained great fame and an extensive literature which is daily increasing has grown up around it it is not my intention to write once again the account already given many times of the origin of this doctrine nor to restate and criticise the now well known passages in which marx and engels asserted the theory nor the different views of its opponents its supporters its exponents and its correctors and corruptors my object is merely to submit to my colleagues some few remarks concerning the doctrine taking it in the form in which it appears in a recent book by professor antonio labriola of the university of rome for many reasons it does not come within my province to praise labriola s book but i cannot help saying as a needful explanation that it appears to me to be the fullest and most adequate treatment of the question the book is free from pedantry and learned tattle whilst it shows in every line signs of the author s complete knowledge of all that has been written on the subject a book in short which saves the annoyance of controversy with erroneous and exaggerated opinions which in it appear as superseded it has a grand opportunity in italy where the materialistic theory of history is

known almost solely in the spurious form bestowed on it by an ingenious professor of economics who even pretends to be its inventor

in this book some of the world's leading economists and experts on Serra explore the enduring appeal of his 1613 *Breve Trattato*

technology and the internet have triggered important changes to how creative works are created and accessed and how creators and copyright-based industries generate their revenues the authors reassess the economics of copyright in the light of these changes after providing an introduction to the economics of copyright they analyze the changes to the baseline copyright model triggered by the new technological landscape then they assess the empirical economic work on copyright so far and suggest future avenues of research and related data needs

relatively little attention yet it seems unlikely that an industry that represents nearly one fifth of the economy could escape the efficiency and cost driven disruptions of ai the economics of artificial intelligence health care challenges brings together contributions from health economists physicians philosophers and scholars in law public health and machine learning to identify the primary barriers to entry of ai in the healthcare sector across original papers and in wide ranging responses the contributors analyze barriers of four types incentives management data availability and regulation they also suggest that ai has the potential to improve outcomes and lower costs understanding both the benefits of and barriers to ai adoption is essential for designing policies that will affect the evolution of the healthcare system

upon hearing that ronald coase had been awarded the nobel prize a fellow economist s first response was to ask with whom coase had shared the prize whether this response was idiosyncratic or not i do not know i expect not part of this type of reaction can no doubt be explained by the fact that coase has often been characterized as an economist who wrote only two significant or influential papers the nature of the firm 1937 and the problem of social cost 1960 and by typical professional standards of significant and influential i e widely read and cited this perception embodies a great deal of truth even subsequent to coase s receipt of the prize this is not to say that there have not been other important works the marginal cost controversy 1946 and the lighthouse in economics 1974 come immediately to mind here only that in a random sample of say one hundred economists one would likely find few who could list a coase bibliography beyond the two classic pieces noted above in spite of coase s significant publication record the purpose of this collection is to assess the development of tensions within and prospects for coasean economics those aspects of economic analysis that have evolved out of coase s path breaking work two major strands of research can be identified here law and economics and the new institutional economics
